




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 24 JANUARY 2026.



Presence of moisture in the atmosphere led to widespread thunderstorms yesterday. The highest rainfall amounts recorded were 95mm (Mukandi), 60mm (Agritex Hauna), 44mm (Mutare Odzi), 41mm (Sanyati), 35mm (Mutasa Zindi), 33mm (Kadoma) and 30mm (Zvishavane), while all other areas received less than 30 mm of rain.

Today, mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across much of the country, with some areas experiencing thunderstorms in the morning and afternoon.



Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland, northern parts of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, northern parts of Matabeleland South and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions at first, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thunderstorms. Localized downpours are probable in places.


Southern parts of Matabeleland South, Masvingo and southern parts of Manicaland Provinces:

Partly cloudy and warm for much of the day. Isolated showers, which may be thundery are likely in places.

Northern parts of Manicaland, Matabeleland North, northern parts of Midlands and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Mostly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm as the day progresses with scattered thunderstorms. Localized heavy rain is likely in places.

Harare Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland, southern parts of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan and Matabeleland South Provinces:

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm under partly cloudy skies in the afternoon. There is a slight chance of isolated thundershowers in some areas.





