




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 02 FEBRUARY 2026.




There were isolated thundershowers over the northern and western parts of the country with the highest rainfall amounts recorded in **Kariba (13 mm)** and **Karoi (12 mm)**.

This morning mostly clear and mild conditions prevailed across much of the country except for the north-western parts which experienced isolated thundershowers. As the day progressed, partly cloudy and warm conditions were experienced countrywide with isolated thundershowers in Mashonaland West, Matabeleland North and Matabeleland South Provinces.



FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: TUESDAY 03 FEBRUARY 2026




All Areas
