




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 25 JANUARY 2026.




Yesterday, most areas had rainfall due to the presence of moisture in the atmosphere. The highest amounts of rainfall were recorded in, **Guruve (72 mm), Mukandi (71 mm), Mutasa Zindi (56 mm), Tarisa Park (Goromonzi) (53 mm), Matopos (46 mm), Nyanga (40 mm), Kadoma (35 mm) and Buffalo Range (32 mm).** The rest of the areas received rainfall less than 30 mm.

This morning mostly cloudy and warm condition prevailed across much parts of the country. As the day progressed, isolated thundershowers developed over the Northern half, while becoming less moist over the south east parts.

Matabeleland North, Mashonaland West, Mashonaland Centra Northern parts of Manicaland:

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions at first, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thunderstorms. Localized downpours are probable in places.


Harare Metropolitan, Bulawayo, Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, Masvingo, Mashonaland East, and south of Manicaland Provinces:

Warm and partly cloudy for much of the day, with a chance of isolated thundery showers in some areas.

Actions to Take:

- The public is advised to avoid crossing flooded rivers to prevent loss of life.
- Seek shelter in a safe building or hard topped vehicle to avoid lightning strikes.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: TUESDAY 27 JANUARY 2026



Northern parts of Manicaland, Matabeleland North, northern parts of Midlands and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Mostly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming warmer as the day progresses, with isolated thunderstorms. Localised heavy rainfall is likely in places.

Harare Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland, southern parts of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan and Matabeleland South Provinces:

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm under partly cloudy skies in the afternoon. There is a slight chance of isolated thundershowers in some areas.

- Seek shelter in a safe building or hard topped vehicle to avoid lightning strikes.
