




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 04 FEBRUARY 2026.

Northern parts of the country experienced isolated thundershowers yesterday. The highest rainfall amounts were recorded in **Guruve (21 mm) and Kariba (9 mm).**

This morning, partly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over much of the country, except in the western areas, which were mostly sunny and warm. As the day progressed, isolated thundershowers developed over parts of Mashonaland West and Matabeleland North, while the rest of the country became partly cloudy and warm

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: THURSDAY 05 FEBRUARY 2026




All Areas:

- Stay hydrated, drink plenty of water to avoid Dehydration.




