



## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 28 JANUARY 2026.




Remnant moisture over the north-western parts of the country resulted in light thundershowers in **Victoria Falls, Karoi, and Chinhoyi** yesterday. The rest of the country experienced fair-weather conditions.

This morning, partly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over the North-Eastern parts of the country, while the remaining areas experienced mostly sunny and mild conditions. By afternoon, conditions were partly cloudy and warm over much of the country. Isolated thundershowers occurred over **Matabeleland North and Mashonaland West Provinces**, while the South-Western regions experienced mostly sunny and warm conditions.



## FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: THURSDAY 29 JANUARY 2026




**All Areas:**

## WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: FRIDAY 30 JANUARY 2026



**Masvingo, Matabeleland South and the Southern parts of the Midland Province:**

Expect cool, windy and partly cloudy conditions at first becoming warm as the day progresses.

**Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Northern parts of Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland all Mashonaland Provinces:**

Mostly sunny and hot in the afternoon. There is a slight chance of brief cloudy periods and isolated showers over the northern districts. Mild both morning and evening.
