




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 20 FEBRUARY 2026.




Yesterday, scattered thunderstorms occurred over the northern half of the country as a result of prevailing atmospheric moisture. The highest rainfall totals were recorded at **Gweru (37 mm), Chibero (32 mm), Kadoma (23 mm) and Chinhoyi (20 mm)**, while the remaining areas received less than 20 mm of rainfall.

Today, mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across much of the country, with scattered thunderstorms occurring in some areas.



FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 21 FEBRUARY 2026



Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, northern parts of Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland, and all Mashonaland provinces:

Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day with scattered thundershowers. Localized downpours are probable in the north-western parts of the country. It should be mild both in the morning and during the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.


Matabeleland South, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland provinces:

Briefly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon, with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery.

Actions to Take:

- Plan with the weather in mind.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: SUNDAY 22 FEBRUARY 2026



Matabeleland North, Mashonaland West, Mashonaland Central, northern parts of Midlands and Harare Metropolitan provinces:

Anticipate partly cloudy and mild conditions at first, becoming mostly cloudy and warm by afternoon with scattered thundershowers. Localized heavy downpours are probable in some areas.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, Manicaland and Mashonaland East provinces:

Mild with brief cloudy periods for much of the day though cool both in the morning and in the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Plan with the weather in mind.
