TOMORROW

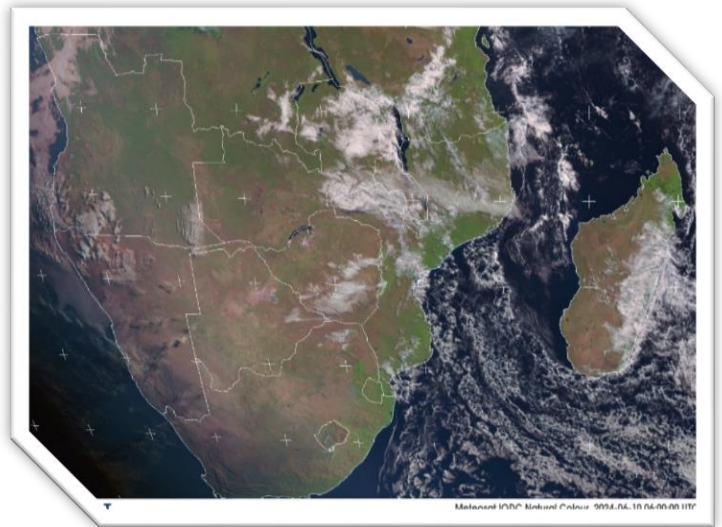
Briefly cloudy, and cool in the South, Mild in the north.

WEEK AT A GLANCE

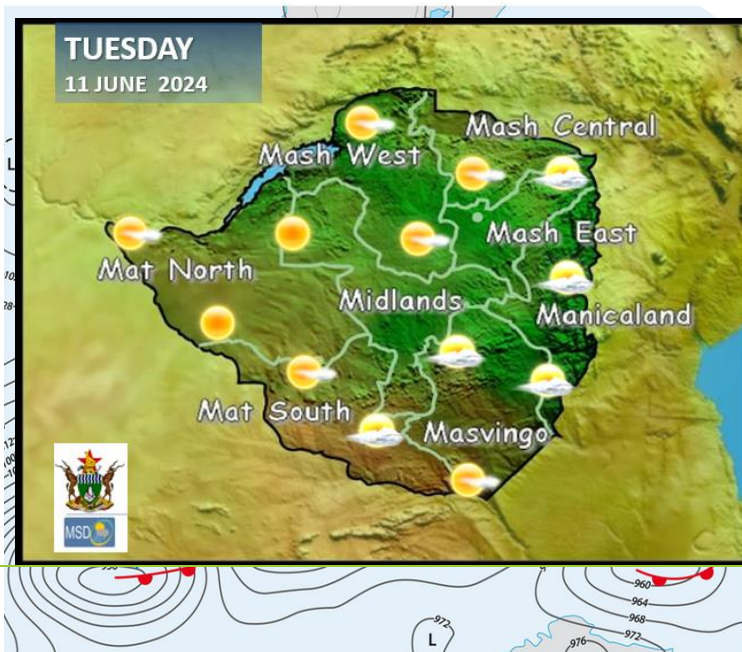
Perfect time to be cozy around a fire. Cold mornings and becoming **warm conditions** during the day **from Wednesday 12 June 2024**



Northern Provinces of the country started off with cold conditions with exception of areas along the **Zambezi Valley** which had cool conditions under clear skies. **Mutoko, Rusape, Wedza and Matopos** had **slight** ground frost. Mostly cloudy, windy and cold conditions were experienced over **Southern Provinces** of the country with **Chisengu** recording drizzle due to the moisture brought in by the south easterly airflow. As the day progressed it became mild and clearing of the clouds continued.



WEATHER FOR TOMORROW TUESDAY 11 JUNE 2024



Anticipate brief cloudy and cold conditions in areas such as **Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands, Mashonaland East and Manicaland Provinces** in the morning. The **remaining Provinces** expect mostly clear skies and cold morning conditions. Ground frost is probable in **Wedza, Marondera, Lupane and Matopos**. However, by afternoon it should become mild.

ACTIONS TO TAKE

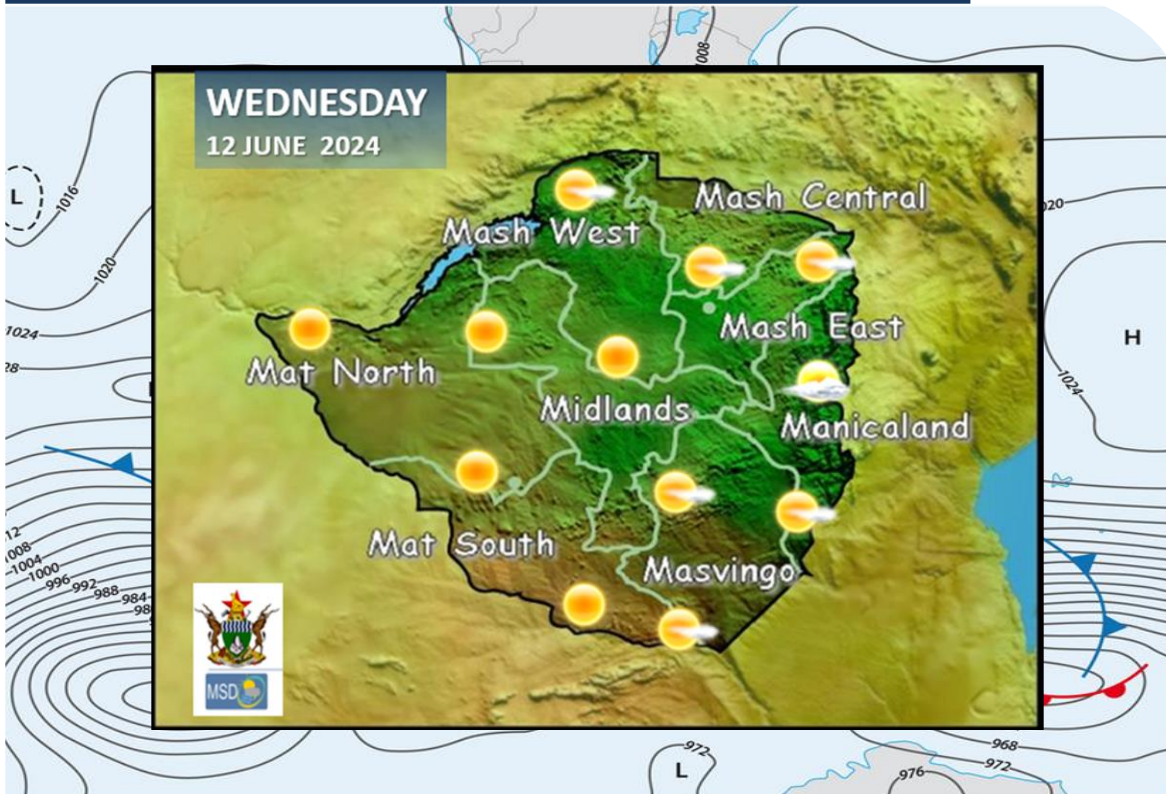
- **Dress warmly**, and ensure vulnerable members of society are kept warm both early morning and late evening.

- If there is need to use a brazier (mbaura/imbaula) or fire to keep warm, **please ensure the room is well ventilated**.
- **Winter cropping plans and activities** should be done in consultation with local Agritex Officers

Ground frost is anticipated over areas such as Matopos, Lupane, Gweru, Nyanga and Mutoko, with mostly clear skies and cold morning conditions across most of the country. However, areas along the Zambezi Valley should be cool at first. In the afternoon, it should become warm.
