




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 26 FEBRUARY 2026.



Scattered thunderstorms were experienced over much of the country with significant rainfall in Kariba (62mm), West Nicholson (56mm), Mvuma (46mm), Beitbridge (45mm) Centenary (42mm), Makoholi (37mm), Karoi (33mm), Shurugwi (35mm), Gweru (33mm), and Kezi (27mm). This cloud system was moving north-eastwards, driven by cool and relatively dry winds over the south.



- Wait at least 30 minutes to resume activities after last bolt of lightning or thunder.

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.


Matabeleland South, Masvingo, Southern parts of Mashonaland East and Manicaland provinces.

Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Masvingo and southern parts of Manicaland provinces.








Partly cloudy and mild at first becoming warm in the afternoon.
