




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 06 MARCH 2026.



Widespread thunderstorms were experienced countrywide with continuous rain during the evening. Heavy rainfall amounts were received in **Wedza (107mm), Mukandi (54mm), Binga (47mm), Chivhu and Chinhoyi (41mm)**. The remaining areas had significant rainfall amounts below 40mm.

This morning cloudy and cool conditions prevailed with light rain and showers in places. As the day progressed, it became partly cloudy and warm in all areas except for areas in Manicaland and Matabeleland North which were mostly cloudy.



- Wait at least 30 minutes to resume activities after last bolt of lightning or thunder.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 07 MARCH 2026



Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo, southern of Manicaland and Mashonaland East provinces.

Mostly cloudy and cool conditions are expected at first, becoming warm in the afternoon with scattered thundershowers and a chance of localized heavy rainfall that may exceed 50mm in twenty-four hours.


Matabeleland North, Mashonaland Central and West, Harare Metropolitan, and northern parts of Manicaland provinces.

Anticipate partly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning, becoming mostly cloudy and warm for the rest of the day. Isolated showers that may be thundery are probable.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Avoid crossing flooded rivers.

All areas:

Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day with scattered thundershowers. Heavy rainfall is probable in **Mashonaland West and East, Midlands, Masvingo, and the southern parts of Manicaland provinces**. Cool and windy conditions both in the morning and during the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Avoid crossing flooded rivers.
- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.


