




## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 08 MARCH 2026.



Presence of atmospheric moisture led to widespread thunderstorms yesterday, with some areas experiencing rain persisting through the night. Notable heavy rainfall totals included **85 mm (Macheke Agritex), 84 mm (Macheke Railway), 70 mm (Belvedere Harare), 66 mm (Chivi Agritex), 57 mm (Domboshava), 54 mm (Maranda Agritex), and 52 mm (Shamva)**. All other areas had significant rainfall amounts below 50mm.

Mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across much of the country today, with scattered thunderstorms over the northern half. In contrast, the southern region experienced relatively cool weather with drizzle, rain and strong winds.



## FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: MONDAY 09 MARCH 2026




**Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo and Manicaland Provinces** Mostly cloudy, cool and windy conditions at first, becoming warm in the afternoon with rain and drizzle in some areas.

**Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, and all Mashonaland Provinces.** Mostly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon. Scattered showers that may be thundery are probable.

**Actions to Take:**

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Avoid crossing flooded rivers.

**Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland.** Mostly cloudy, cool and windy conditions in the morning, becoming warm as the day progresses. There is a chance of showers in some areas.

**Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland Provinces.** Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day with light winds. Scattered thundershowers are probable in some areas.

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.


