





SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 09 MARCH 2026.



The cloud-band from the west which was now more inclined to the eastern parts of the country was coupled with moisture driven in by relatively cool winds from the south-east. This led to considerable rainfalls in Masvingo, Manicaland, southern parts of the Midlands and Mashonaland East provinces, with **Bikita receiving 94mm**. Other areas with notable falls included **Chisengu (59mm), Arcturus mine (42mm), Sanyati (40mm), Mukandi and Nyanyadzi (36mm), Wedza (34mm) and Parkinson Secondary School in Shurugwi (30mm)**.

By this morning, these strengthening south-easterly winds were giving rise to cloudy, cool and drizzly conditions in **Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, Manicaland and southern districts of the Midlands**. Meanwhile, it was mostly cloudy and warm in the northern-half of the country, with isolated showers.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: TUESDAY 10 MARCH 2026




Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo and Manicaland Provinces Cloudy, and cool with light winds in the morning, becoming mild by afternoon with rain and drizzle in some areas.

Matabeleland North, northern parts of Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, and all Mashonaland Provinces. Mostly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with isolated showers that may be thundery in some places. Mild at first and towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Avoid crossing flooded rivers.

Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland. Mostly cloudy and mild for much of the day with a light breeze now and again. Patchy drizzle is probable especially over higher ground (mountains and hilly areas).

Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, northern parts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland Provinces. Mostly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning, becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with isolated showers that may be thundery.


Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.


