





SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, TUESDAY 10 MARCH 2026.



The cloud system over the eastern parts of the country yesterday coupled with cool, moist winds from the south-east, led to notable rainfall totals in **Chisengu (63mm), Bikita (50mm), Mukandi (31mm), Bindura (24mm), Mutasa (22mm) and Rusape(20mm).**

Today, the relatively moist south-easterly winds resulted in cloudy, windy and cool conditions with drizzle and rain in **Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, Manicaland and southern districts of the Midlands** for much of the day. Meanwhile, mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed in the northern-half of the country, with isolated showers.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: WEDNESDAY 11 MARCH 2026




Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland. Cloudy and cool morning conditions with light winds and patchy drizzle. Mild in the afternoon with and isolated showers.

Matabeleland North, Bulawayo and Harare Metropolitans, northern parts of Midlands, northern parts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland Provinces. Mostly cloudy and mild at first, becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with a slight chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in some places.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Avoid crossing flooded rivers.

Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland. Mostly cloudy and mild conditions should prevail for much of the day, with a light breeze now and again. Moderate rain is probable in some places.

Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, northern parts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland Provinces. Briefly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning, becoming partly cloudy and warm as the day progresses with isolated thundershowers.

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.




