





## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 13 MARCH 2026.



Cloudy and warm conditions were experienced over the southern parts of the country yesterday, with rain and showers. Notable rainfall totals included **46 mm at Grand Reef Airport (Mutare), 33 mm in Rusape, 31 mm in Buffalo Range, 23 mm in Chisengu, and 21 mm in Mutasa.**

Today, much of the country experienced cloudy and warm conditions, with some areas experiencing occasional rain and patches of drizzle.

Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day, with scattered thundershowers in some areas; though partly cloudy and mild in the morning.


**Southern parts of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan and Matabeleland South Provinces**
