





## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 16 MARCH 2026.



The presence of moisture countrywide led to scattered thundershowers over the northern areas and rain with notable rainfall amounts in **Zaka(58mm), Gweru(34mm), Kanyemba(33mm), Mutare(16mm), Zvishavane(14mm) and Kezi(11mm)**. The remaining areas had less than 10mm of precipitation.

This morning, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed countrywide except for areas in Matabeleland North which had mostly clear skies. As the day progressed scattered thundershowers were experienced over **Mashonaland West, Bulawayo Metropolitan and both Matabeleland provinces**. Meanwhile there is a low-pressure system that is currently over the northern parts of Mozambique and Zambia that is expected to intensify convective activity.

## FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: TUESDAY 17 MARCH 2026



**Matabeleland North, Midlands, northern parts of Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan, and all Mashonaland Provinces:**

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning with chances of light rain and showers. Cloudy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thundershowers and a likelihood of localized heavy rainfall.


**Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Manicaland, Matabeleland South and Masvingo Provinces**

Briefly cloudy and mild at first, becoming mostly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in places.

- **Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.**
- **Avoid crossing flooded rivers.**

## WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: WEDNESDAY 18 MARCH 2026



**Matabeleland North, Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland provinces.**

Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day with scattered thundershowers towards the end of the day. Localized downpours are probable. Mild conditions both in the morning and overnight.

**Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South and Masvingo Provinces**

Partly cloudy and mild at first becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery. Mild conditions overnight.
