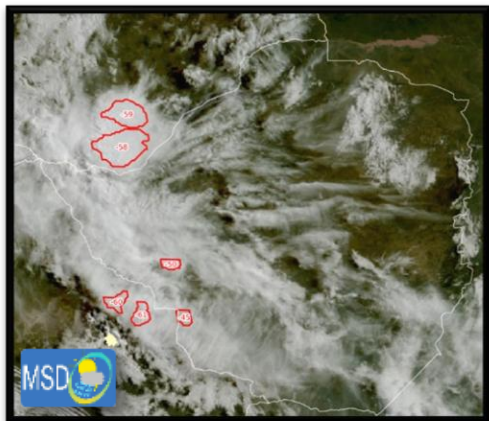




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 20 APRIL 2026.

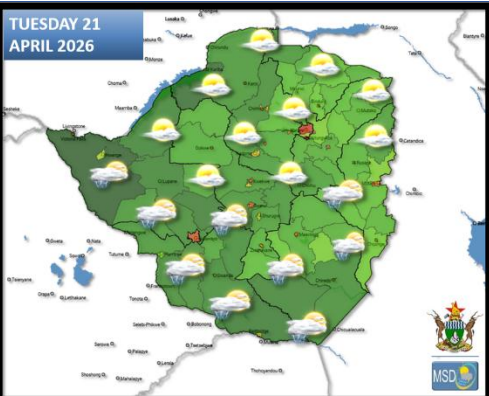


A cloud system over the country resulted in scattered thundershowers yesterday, mainly over the southern half of the country into Manicaland province. The highest rainfall totals were recorded in **Nyanga and Chivi (20mm), Chimanimani (19mm), West Nicholson (13mm) and Victoria Falls (8mm).**

Early this morning, much of the country was cloudy with mild conditions. As the day progressed, the southern half of the country became mostly cloudy and warm, with scattered thundershowers. Elsewhere, partly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed in the afternoon, with isolated thundershowers.

Matabeleland North, Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo, and Manicaland provinces

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming mostly cloudy and warm in the afternoon, with scattered thundershowers. Mild towards evening.

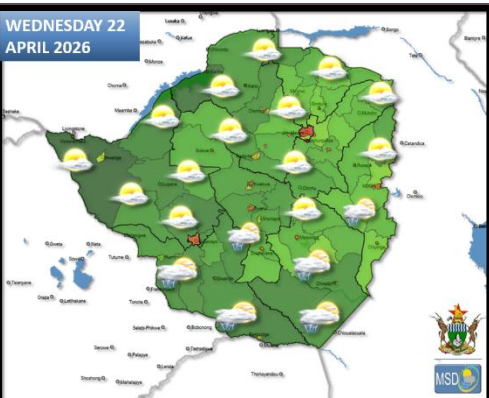
Mashonaland West, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland East and Mashonaland Central provinces

Mild morning conditions under mostly sunny skies, becoming partly cloudy and warm as the day progresses with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Warm clothing might be required in the evening, especially if outdoors.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: WEDNESDAY 22 APRIL 2026



Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, and Manicaland provinces

Partly cloudy and mild at first, becoming warm in the afternoon with isolated thundershowers. It should be cool overnight.

Actions to Take:

- Seek shelter in a safe building to avoid lightning strikes.
- Warm clothing might be required in the evening, especially if outdoors.

Northern parts of Midlands, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces

Mostly sunny and warm conditions for much of the day with brief cloudy periods and a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery. Mild both in the morning and towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Keep hydrated by drinking adequate amounts of water.
