



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 01 APRIL 2026.

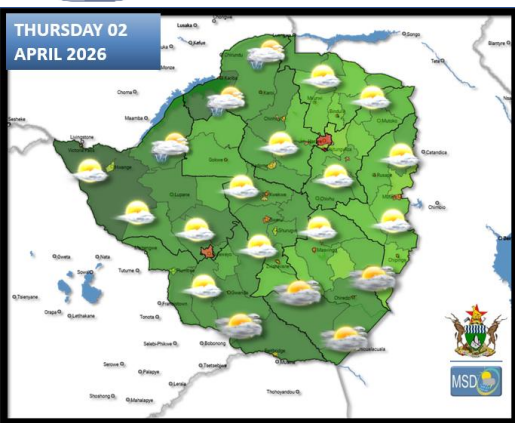


Isolated thunderstorms occurred yesterday, mainly over the eastern and northern parts of the country, with some of the highest recorded rainfall totals being **52 mm in Wedza, 27 mm in Karoi, and 20 mm in Chisengu**. This resulted from a combination of moisture from two different systems: cool, moist winds from the southeast and warm, moist air from the northwest.

Today, mostly cloudy and mild conditions with light winds prevailed across much of the country in the morning. Conditions became warm by afternoon, with parts of all **Mashonaland Provinces** experiencing isolated thundershowers.

Partly cloudy, and warm conditions for much of the day with isolated thundershowers mainly over the northwestern districts. It should be mild towards evening.

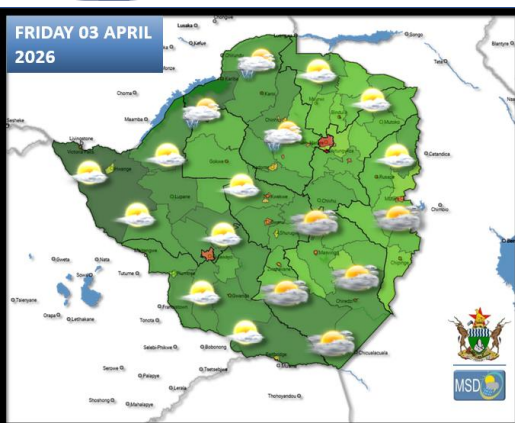
Actions to Take:

Actions to Take:

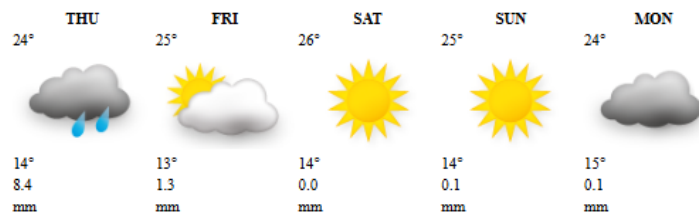
- **Keep hydrated by drinking adequate amounts of water.**



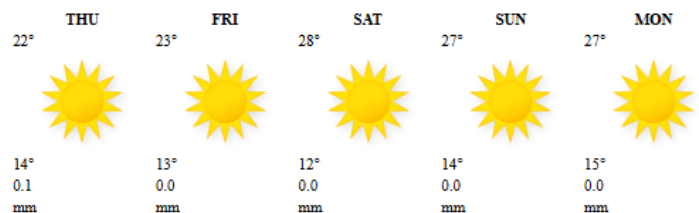
