



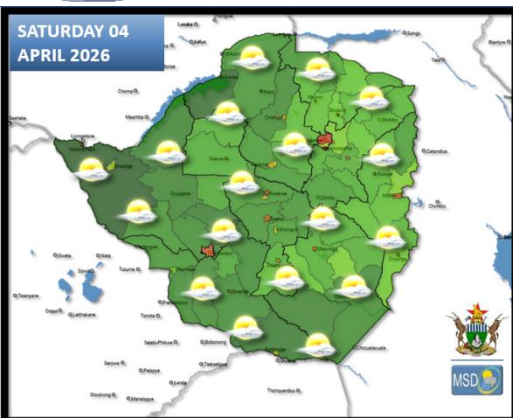
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 03 APRIL 2026.

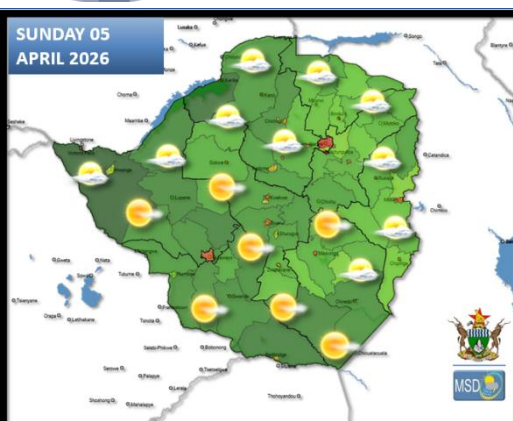
ALL AREAS

Mostly sunny and mild at first, becoming warm by noon. Mild towards evening.

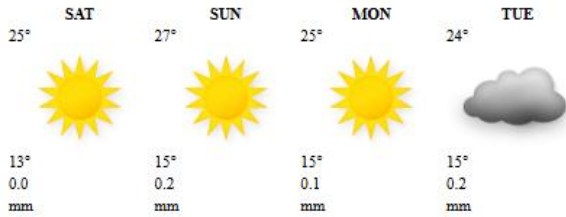
