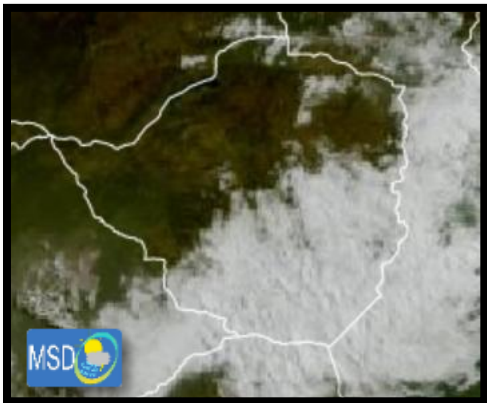




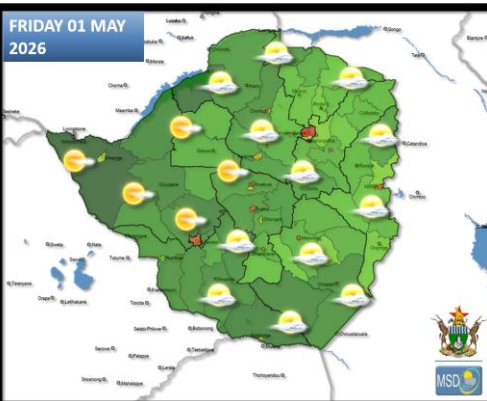
## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 30 APRIL 2026.



Mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed this morning with rain and drizzle in Matabeleland South, Midlands, Masvingo, Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan as well as parts of Mashonaland East and Central provinces. The highest rainfall recorded was 55mm in Chipinge and 14 mm in Chisengu. The remaining provinces had mostly clear skies with mild conditions. As the day progressed, cloudy conditions persisted in Masvingo, Matabeleland South and Manicaland whereas Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland East and Mashonaland central became partly cloudy and warm.

- Warm clothing might be required in the morning and evening, especially if outdoors.

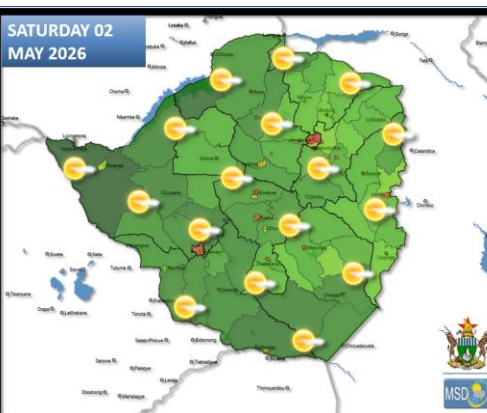
**Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, Mashonaland West**
