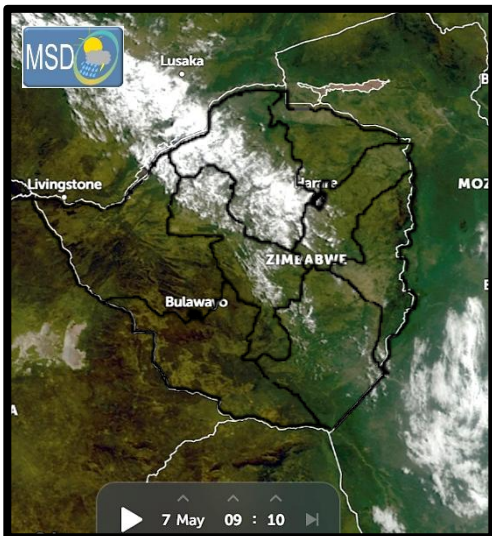


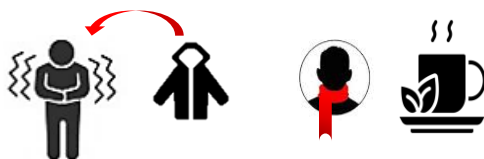


SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 07 MAY 2026.



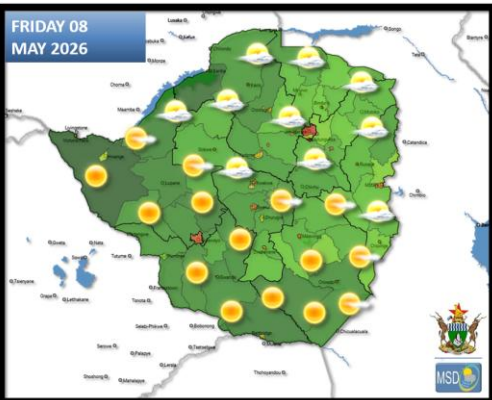
Cold conditions prevailed over much of the areas in all Matabeleland and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces with lowest temperatures recorded in **Matopos and Plumtree(5°C), Tsholotsho and Hwange (8°C), Bulawayo Metropolitan (9°C)**, and surrounding areas. The rest of the country had cool conditions in the morning but areas along the Zambezi and Limpopo valleys experienced mild conditions. Mostly clear skies prevailed countrywide except for areas in Mashonaland West and the Midlands provinces which had scattered clouds early in the morning.

As the day progressed, the cloud system traversed north-eastwards resulting in mostly cloudy and warm conditions over the Midlands, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces.

Harare Metropolitan, the northern parts of Manicaland, the Midlands and all Mashonaland provinces:

Anticipate scattered clouds in the morning with mild conditions becoming briefly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers. Partly cloudy and mild conditions are expected towards the evening.

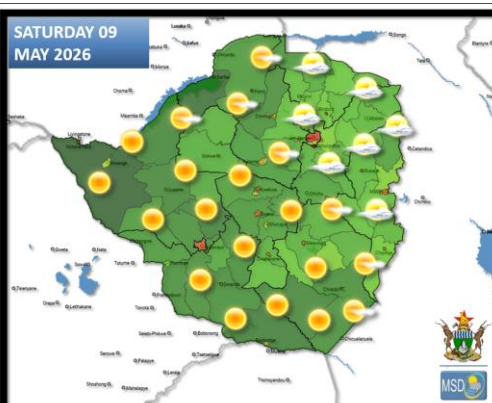
The southern parts of Manicaland, Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South and Masvingo provinces.

Clear skies and cool conditions in the morning with a chance of slight ground frost in Matopos, Kezi and Gwanda. Mostly sunny and warm in the afternoon becoming mild towards the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Warm clothing might be required in the morning and evening, especially if outdoors.
- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.

Partly cloudy and warm for much of the day though mild both in the morning and towards the evening.

The southern parts of Manicaland, Midlands, Matabeleland and South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands and Masvingo and all Mashonaland provinces:

Clear skies and cool conditions in the morning. For the south western areas expect cold conditions and a chance of slight ground frost in Matopos, Kezi and Gwanda

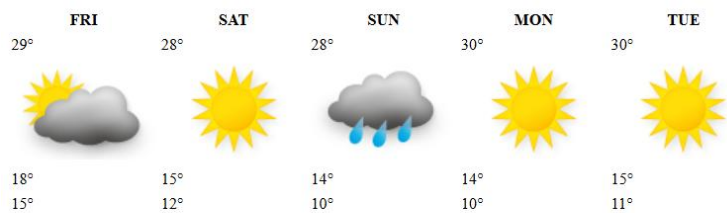
Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm.

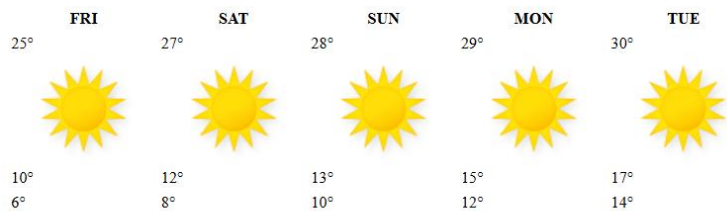
