



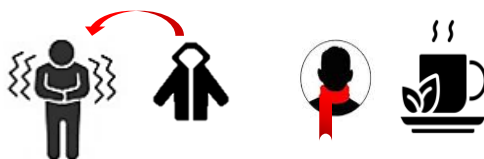
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 08 MAY 2026.



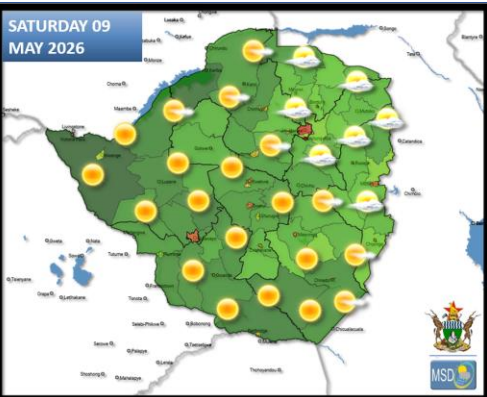
The day began cold over much of Midlands, all Matabeleland, and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces, with slight to moderate frost recorded in **Plumtree (1°C)**, **Gwanda (0.4°C)**, and surrounding areas. The rest of the country experienced cool morning conditions, while areas along the Zambezi valley were mild. Mostly clear skies prevailed countrywide, except for the north-eastern districts, which were partly cloudy in the morning.

As the day progressed, it became warm across all areas, with isolated showers occurring in parts of Mashonaland East, Harare Metropolitan, and Manicaland provinces.

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in some areas. Cool towards the evening.

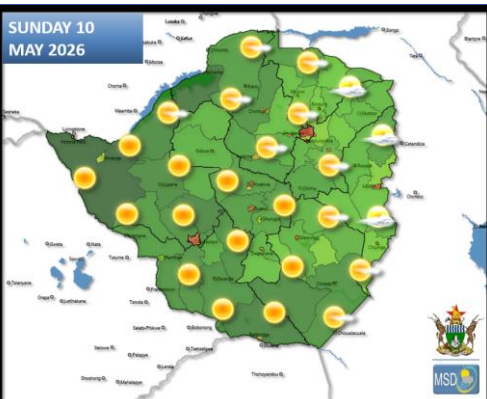
Midlands, all Matabeleland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, Mashonaland West provinces.

Clear skies and cool conditions at first with a chance of slight ground frost in Gwanda. Mostly sunny and warm in the afternoon becoming cool towards the evening.

- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.

Harare Metropolitan, Midlands, all Matabeleland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, all Mashonaland provinces.

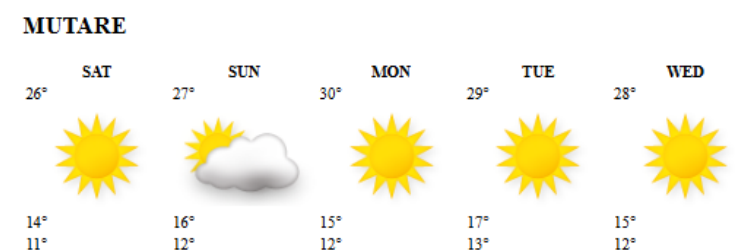
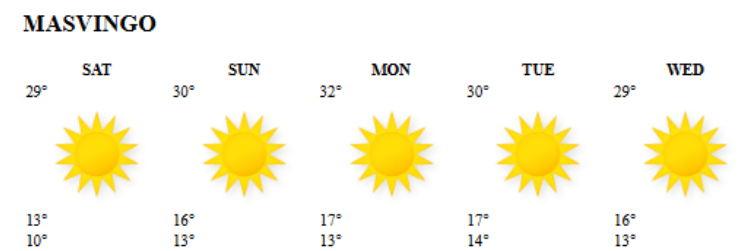
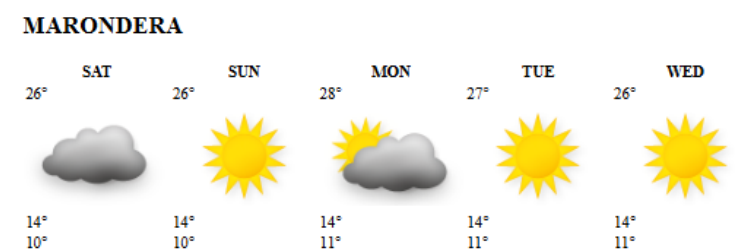
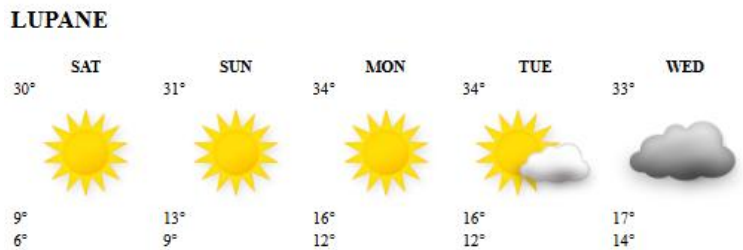
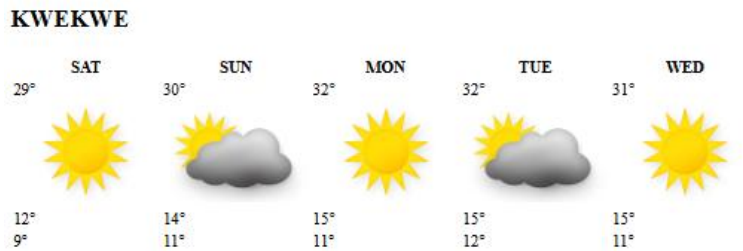
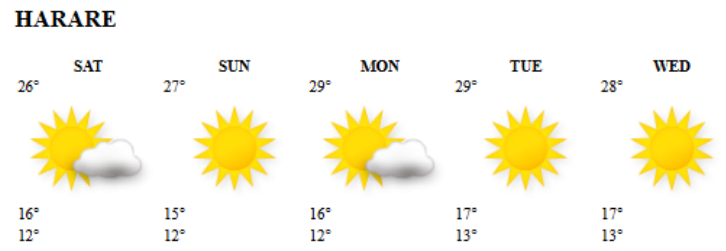
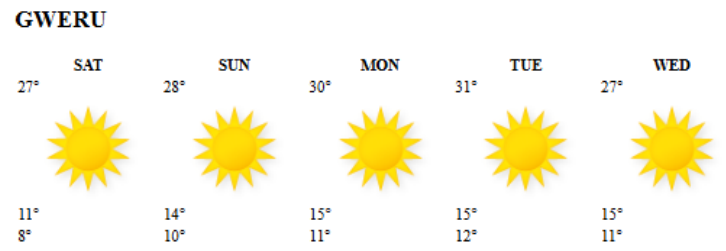
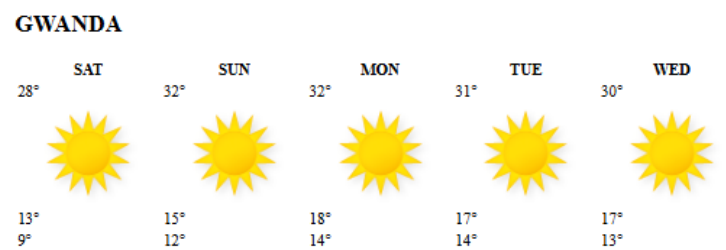
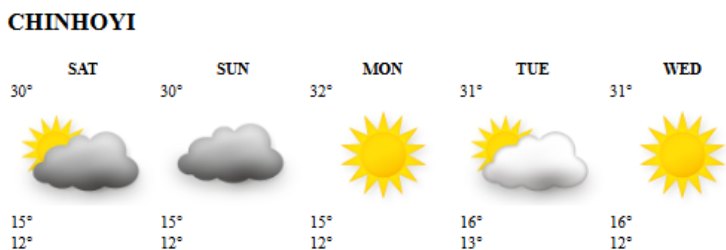
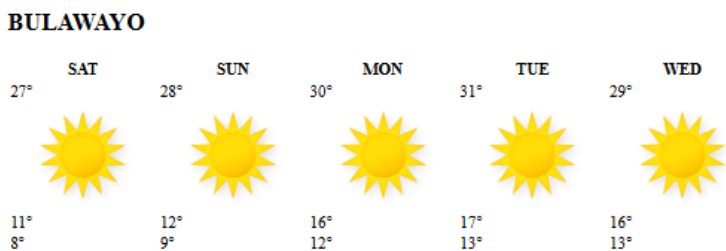
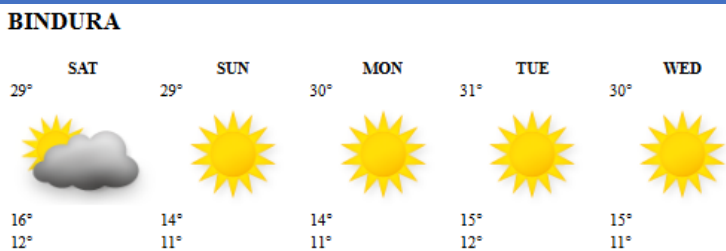
Clear skies and mild conditions in the morning becoming hot as the day progresses. Mild towards the evening.

- Keep hydrated during the day.



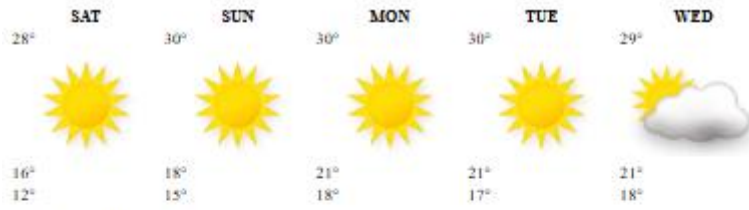
MAIN CITIES FORECAST: SATURDAY 09 – WEDNESDAY 12 MAY 2026
