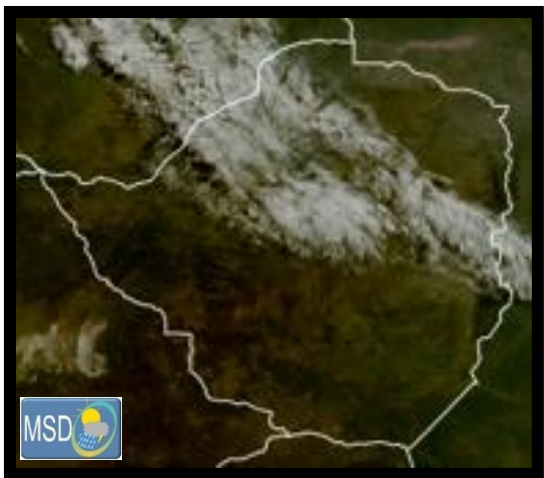




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, TUESDAY 12 MAY 2026.



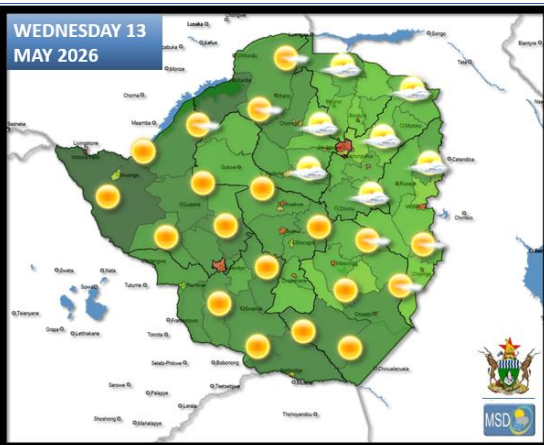
Cold conditions prevailed over much of the Matabeleland provinces this morning, with slight to moderate frost recorded in Matopos and surrounding areas. The lowest temperatures were recorded in **Matopos (4°C), Gwanda (7°C), Kezi and Lupane (8°C),** as well as **Nkayi and Gweru (9°C).** The rest of the country experienced cool morning conditions, while areas along the Zambezi valley were mild. Mostly clear skies prevailed countrywide, except for the north-western districts, which were partly cloudy in the morning.

As the day progressed, it became warm across all areas with scattered cloud in the northern half of the country.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: WEDNESDAY 13 MAY 2026



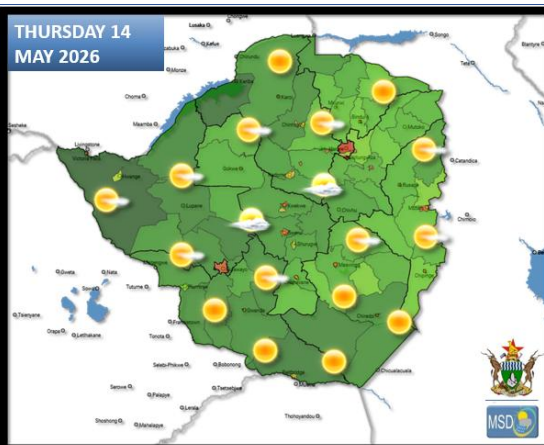
Mashonaland East and Central, Harare Metropolitan and northern parts of Manicaland provinces: Partly cloudy and cool in the morning becoming warm in the afternoon. Cool towards the evening.

Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Manicaland and all Matabeleland provinces: Clear skies and cool conditions at first with a slight chance of ground frost in areas such as Matopos and Bulawayo Metropolitan. Mostly sunny and warm in the afternoon becoming cool towards the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Warm clothing might be required in the morning and evening, especially if outdoors.
- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.
- Keep hydrated during the day.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: THURSDAY 14 MAY 2026



Matabeleland North, Midlands, Mashonaland West, Harare Metropolitan and northern parts of Masvingo provinces: Partly cloudy and warm for much of the day. Cool in the morning and overnight.

Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, southern parts of Masvingo and Manicaland provinces: Clear skies and cool morning conditions, with a chance of slight ground frost in areas such as Matopos and Gwanda, becoming warm as the day progresses. Cool conditions towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm in the early morning hours and toward evening.
- Keep hydrated during the day.
