

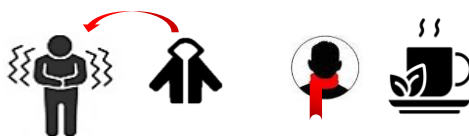


## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 14 MAY 2026.



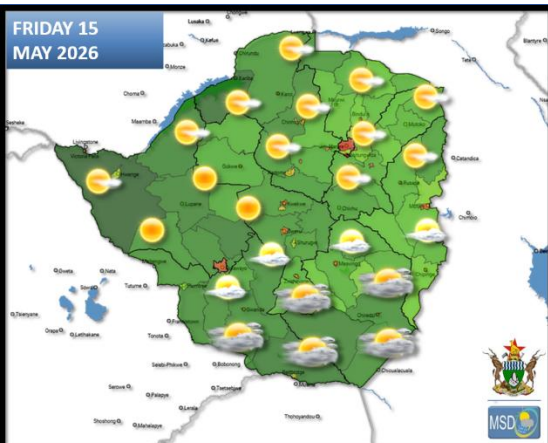
A relatively dry and cold airflow emanating from the south-west brought cold conditions to Matabeleland North and South Provinces this morning. In its wake, the lowest air temperatures were 3 °C (Matopos), 5 °C (West Nicholson), and 7 °C (Kezi and Lupane), with slight ground frost in Matopos (2 °C). On the other hand, the Zambezi Valley had mild morning conditions, while the rest of the country was in the cool category.

Since then, the airflow has veered to a south-easterly direction and drawn in moisture from the Indian Ocean. As a result, these now-moist southeasterly winds are beginning to drive scattered clouds into the Chiredzi and Mwenzezi districts.

**Masvingo, Matabeleland South and southern areas of Manicaland provinces:**  
Cloudy and cool at first becoming less cloudy and mild by afternoon. Cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

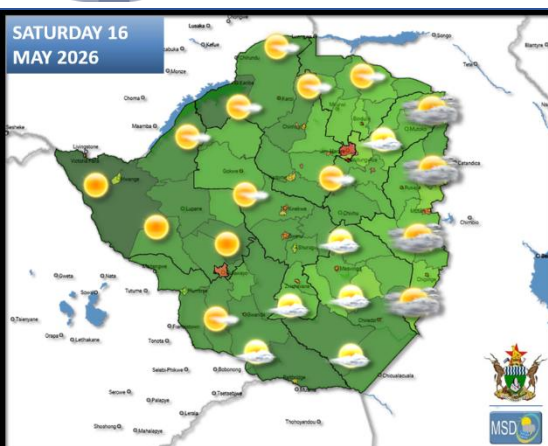
- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.

**Matabeleland North, Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland and all Mashonaland provinces:**  
Mostly sunny and hot for much of the day, though cool in the morning and overnight.

Actions to Take:

- Keep hydrated during the day.

## WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: SATURDAY 16 MAY 2026



**Manicaland Province, north-eastern districts of Mashonaland East and Masvingo Province:**  
Cloudy and cool in the morning, becoming partly cloudy and mild by noon and warm; windy and cool towards evening.

**Matabeleland South and the bulk of Masvingo provinces:**  
Partly cloudy and cold at first becoming mostly sunny and mild by afternoon. Cold and windy towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm in the early morning and evening hours.

**Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland West and Central provinces, and much of Mashonaland East:**  
Cool morning conditions becoming mostly sunny and hot in the afternoon. cold towards evening.

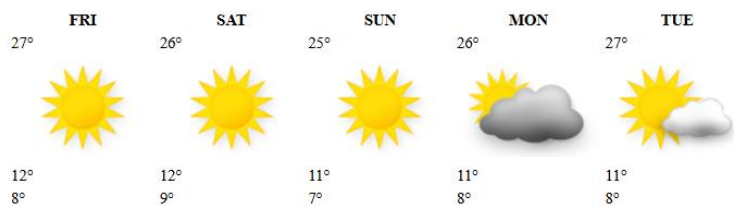
