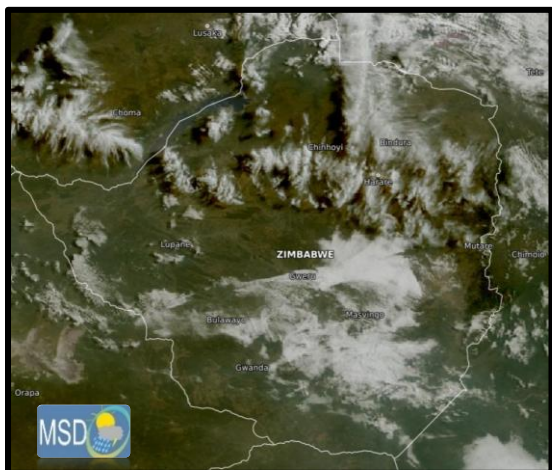




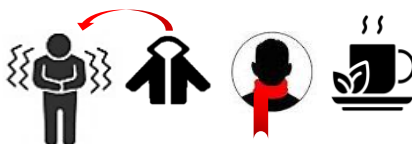
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 16 MAY 2026.



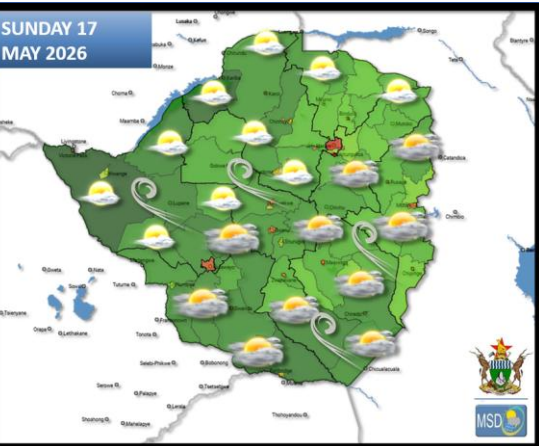
Cold conditions were experienced this morning across Matabeleland South Province, with slight ground frost occurring in Gwanda. The rest of the country experienced cool conditions, except for areas along the Zambezi Valley, which were mild. Cloudy conditions prevailed over much of the southern region, resulting from the remnant moisture in the atmosphere.

By afternoon, temperatures had risen to warm levels across the country under partly cloudy skies. Meanwhile, there is another inflow of cool, moist winds emanating from the southeast.

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm in the early morning and evening hours.

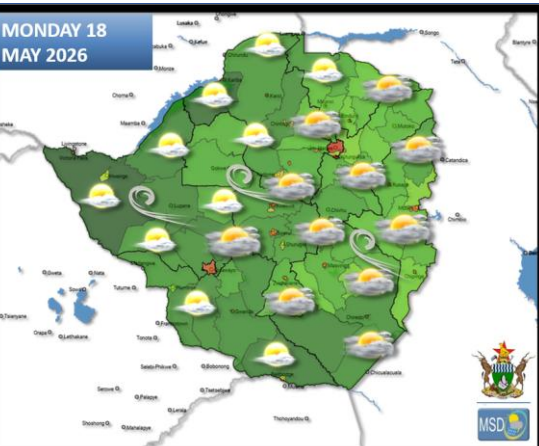
Matabeleland North, northern parts of Midlands, Mashonaland West and Central provinces.
