



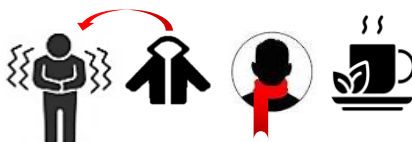
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 18 MAY 2026.



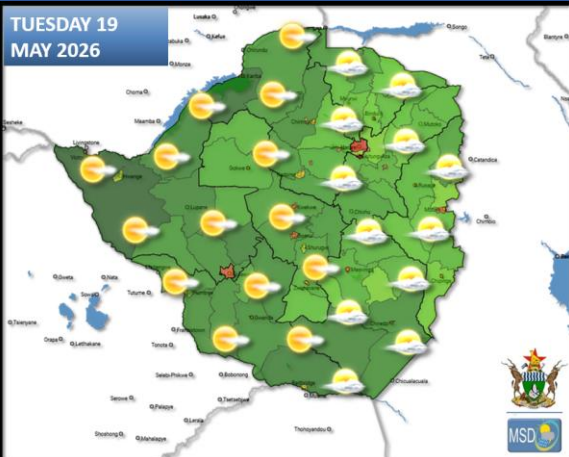
This morning, cool south easterlies brought mostly cloudy and cool conditions over the southern provinces, namely Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, and the southern parts of the Midlands and Manicaland provinces, with patchy drizzle recorded in some areas in these provinces. The rest of the country had mostly clear skies with cool conditions.

As the day progressed, the southern provinces became less cloudy with warm conditions. Meanwhile, scattered clouds developed over all Mashonaland provinces, as well as Harare Metropolitan, under mild conditions.

Briefly cloudy with light rain and drizzle. Cool in the morning becoming mild by afternoon with light winds. Cool towards evening.

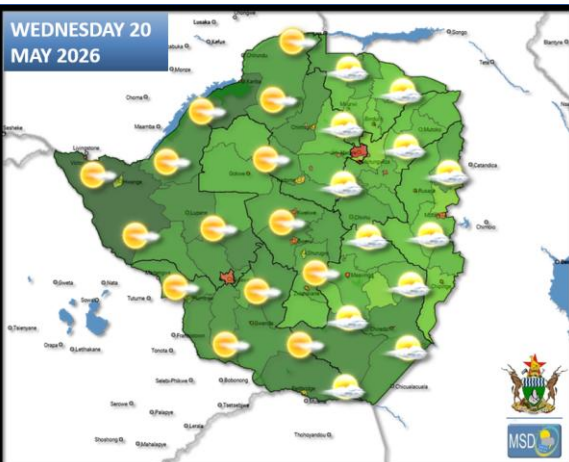
Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, Mashonaland West and Midlands provinces:

Actions to Take:

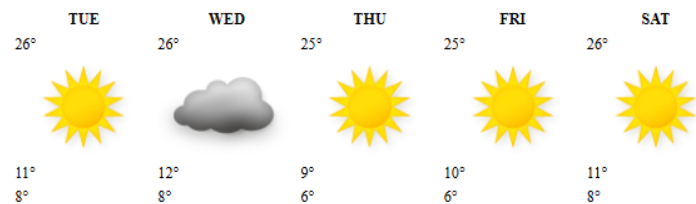
