SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 20 MAY 2026.



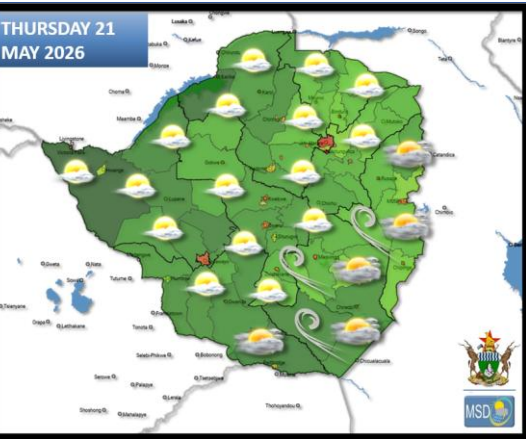
Isolated thundershowers occurred yesterday evening in parts of Bulawayo Metropolitan and Matabeleland South. These resulted from a field of moisture that drifted into the country from Botswana late in the afternoon, before being rapidly driven further northeast by cool winds originating from the South African coastline.

This morning, cool conditions prevailed across much of the country, except for areas along the Zambezi Valley, which were mild. As the day progressed, conditions became mild with partly cloudy skies across the country.

Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Manicaland and Masvingo provinces

Mostly cloudy, windy and cold in the morning with a chance of drizzle and light rain in some areas. Becoming cool in the afternoon.

Actions to Take:

If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.

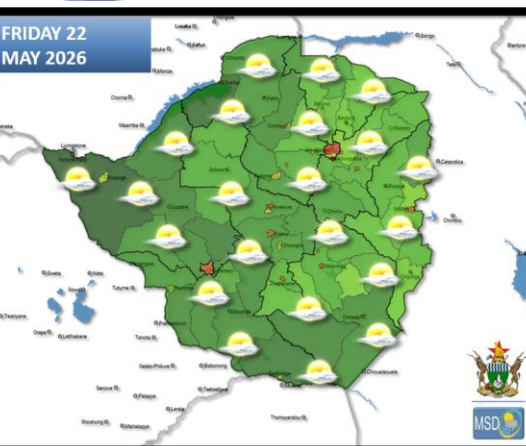
Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan and all Mashonaland, provinces:

Cool and windy in the morning, becoming mild in the afternoon under partly cloudy skies.

Actions to Take:

- **Ensure that children and the elderly are kept warm during the early morning and evening hours.**

All Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan, Midlands, Manicaland, Matabeleland South, and Masvingo provinces:

Mild for much of the day, with brief cloudy periods. Cool both morning and evening.

Actions to Take:

- **If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.**

Matabeleland North, and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces

Clear and cool at first becoming mild and partly cloudy as the day progresses.

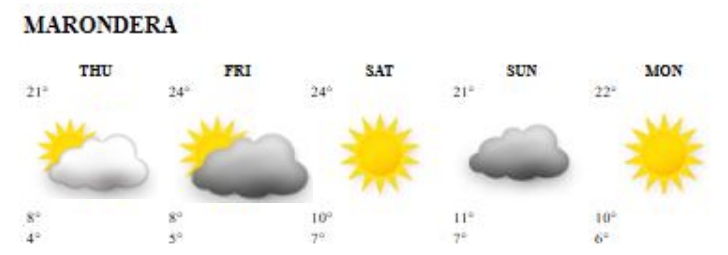
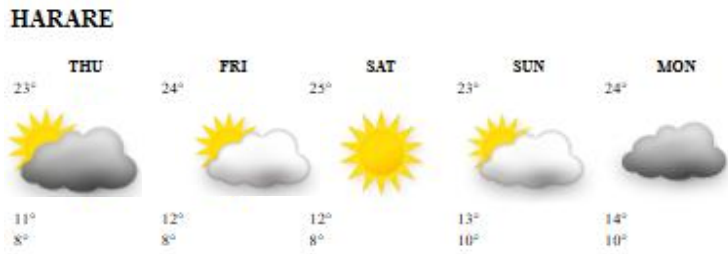
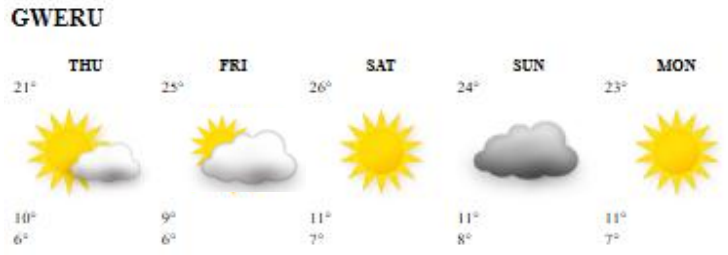
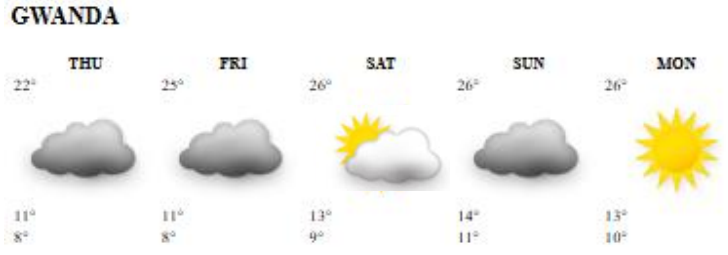
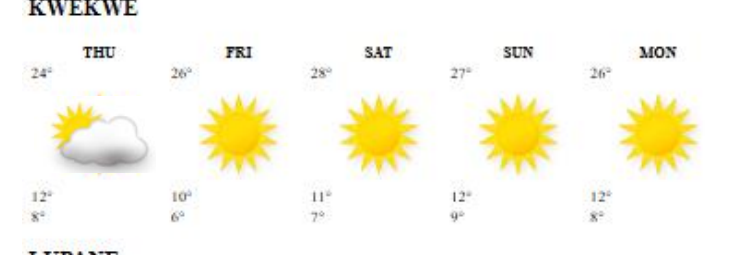
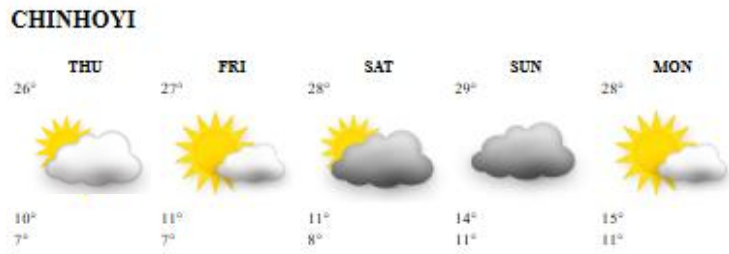
Actions to Take:
