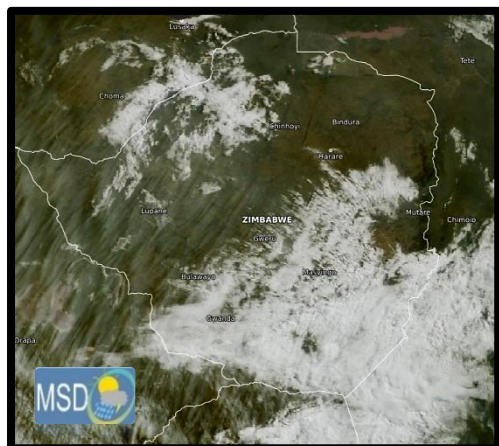




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 21 MAY 2026.

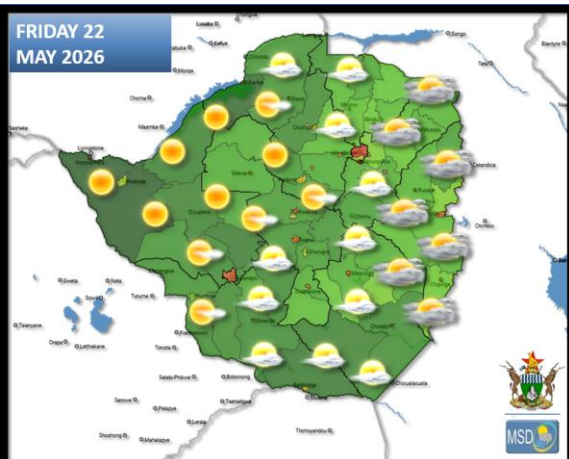


In the early hours of the morning, it was cold over the Highveld (areas near and along the Harare–Bulawayo Highway), cool in the Middle-veld, and mild in the Zambezi and Save Valleys, with mostly clear skies. However, just before sunrise, relatively moist winds from the southeast drove clouds into Manicaland, Masvingo, and Matabeleland South Provinces, making these areas cool for much of the day. Towards evening, it became cold again as the winds slowly veered to a northeasterly direction.

Areas along and to the north of the Highveld experienced mostly clear skies. It was cool at first, becoming mild by afternoon with a light breeze at times.

Meanwhile, a weak cloud system is approaching the country from Botswana

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: FRIDAY 22 MAY 2026



Mashonaland East, Manicaland Provinces and north-eastern parts of Masvingo Province

Mostly cloudy, windy and cold in the morning with drizzle in some areas. Becoming less cloudy and cool in the afternoon.

Actions to Take:

If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.

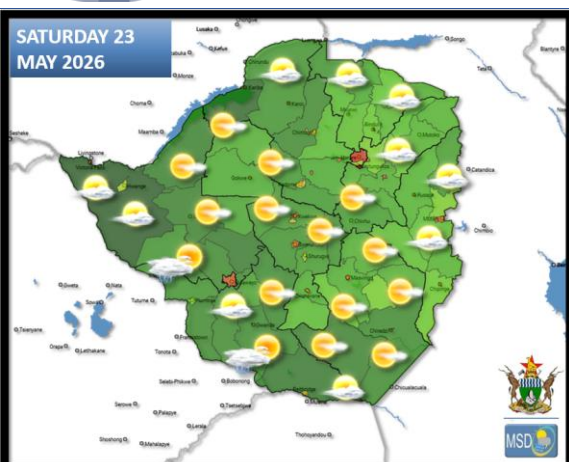
Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, the greater part of Masvingo Province, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland, West and Central Provinces:

Mostly sunny and mild by day. Though cool both morning and evening in most areas with brief cloudy interludes and a light breeze. Cold morning conditions remain probable in areas such as Matopos and Gweru.

Actions to Take:

- **Ensure that children and the elderly are kept warm.**

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan and southern parts of Matabeleland North

Mild for much of the day, with brief cloudy periods and isolated thundershowers. Cool both morning and evening.

Actions to Take:

- **Always remember that; when thunder roars, it is best to be indoors: even in winter.**

Midlands, Masvingo, Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Matabeleland North and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Cool at first becoming mild by noon with mostly clear skies. Cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- **Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm.**



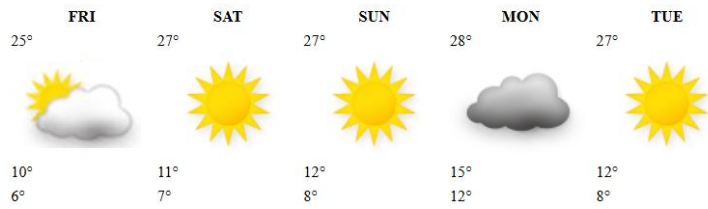
