

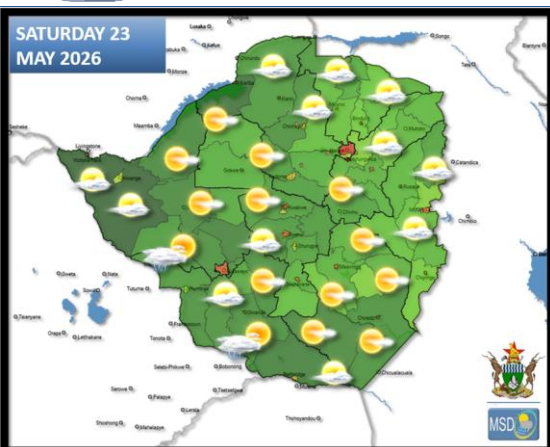
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 22 MAY 2026.



Mostly clear skies overnight over much of the country led to cold morning conditions in the **northern parts of Manicaland, Mashonaland East, Mashonaland Central, as well as Matabeleland North and Matabeleland South provinces.** However, just before sunrise, clouds returned to cover **Matabeleland South, Masvingo, Manicaland, the southern parts of the Midlands, and Mashonaland East and Central provinces.** This happened as easterly winds brought in more moisture, though by evening those winds had begun to die down.

Meanwhile, more moisture is moving into the country from the west, as a weak cloud band approaches from Botswana. This led to scattered clouds over much of the country by afternoon, with mild conditions in most places.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 23 MAY 2026



Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan and southern parts of Matabeleland North

Mild for much of the day, with brief cloudy periods and isolated thundershowers. Cool both morning and evening.

Actions to Take:

- **Always remember that; when thunder roars, it is best to be indoors: even in winter.**

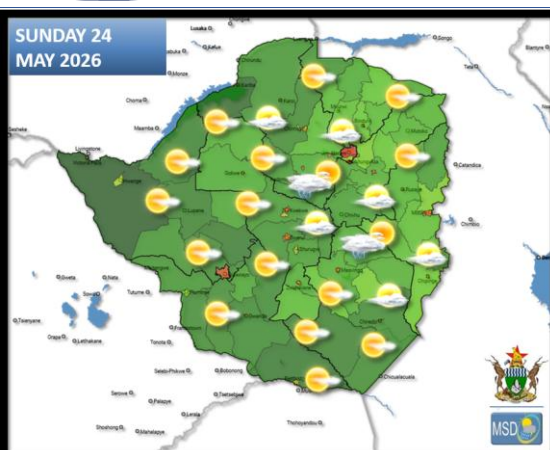
Midlands, Masvingo, Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Matabeleland North and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Cool at first becoming mild by noon with mostly clear skies. Cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- **Ensure that children and the elderly are kept warm, especially overnight.**

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: SUNDAY 24 MAY 2026



Harare Metropolitan, Midlands, northern districts of Masvingo, Mashonaland East and Central,

Mostly sunny and warm by day, though brief cloudy periods and light showers remain probable, possibly accompanied by lightning. Early morning hours will be cold, but evening is set to be cool.

Actions to Take:

- **It is not safe to hide under a tree when there is thunder and lightning.**

Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, Matabeleland South, Mashonaland West and the bulk of Masvingo Province:

Cold in the early morning hours becoming warm by afternoon with mostly sunny skies. Cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- **Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm.**



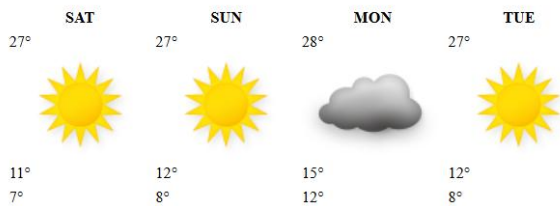
