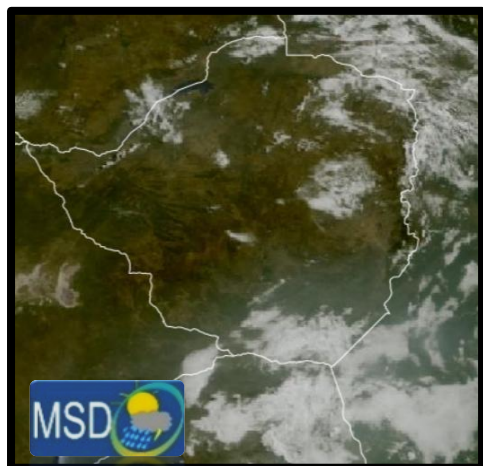




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 25 MAY 2026.



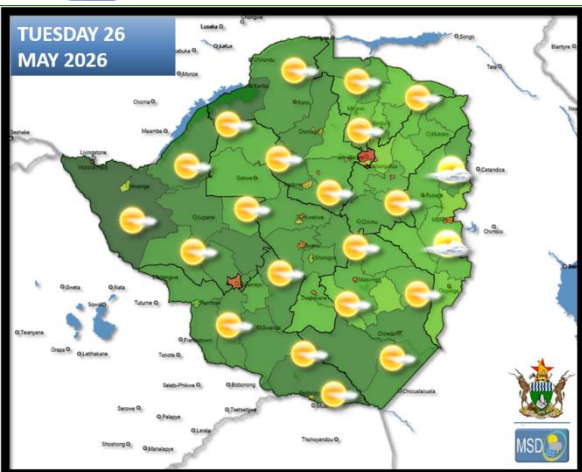
This morning, scattered cloud covered the southern parts of Masvingo, northern districts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland provinces, with light rain recorded in **Macheke (5mm)**. Cool conditions prevailed across much of the country, while the Zambezi Valley remained mild.

By afternoon, conditions became warm countrywide as the cloud gradually dissipated.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: TUESDAY 26 MAY 2026



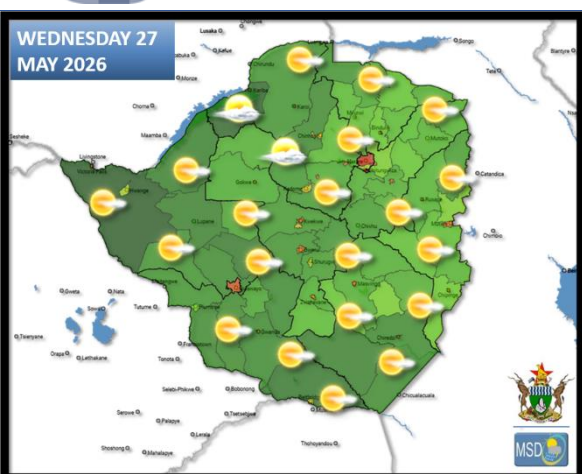
All Areas:

Mostly sunny and mild for much of the day, though cool overnight in most parts of the country. Cold at first, except the Zambezi valley which should be cool; with a chance of slight ground frost in Gwanda, Gweru and Matopos.

Actions to Take:

- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.
- Ensure that children and the elderly are kept warm, especially in the morning and overnight.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: WEDNESDAY 27 MAY 2026



Countrywide:

Mostly clear skies and cold conditions at first, except for areas along the Zambezi Valley which should be cool. There is a chance of ground frost in Matopos and surrounding areas. Mild by afternoon though cooler towards the evening.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm.
- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated
