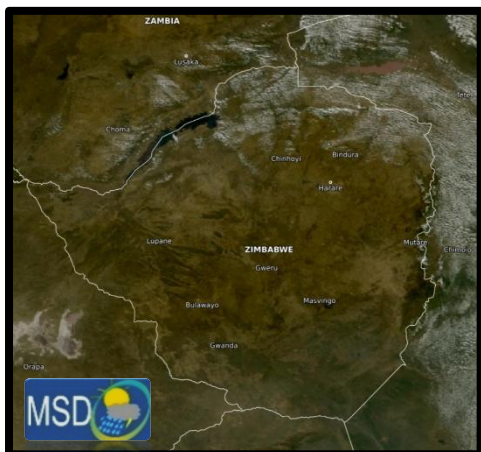




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 28 MAY 2026.

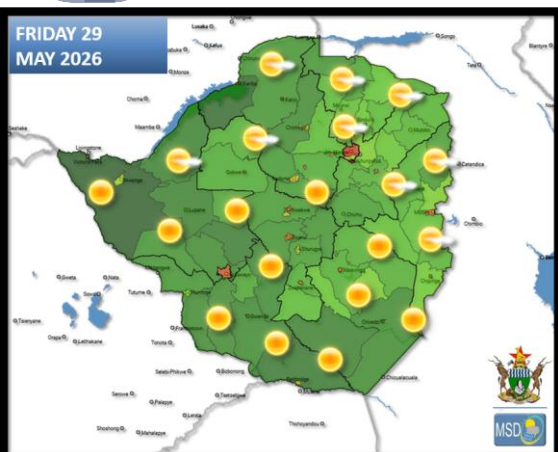


It was cold over much of the country, with slight ground frost in **Matopos (1°C), Nyanga (1°C), Gweru (2°C) Henderson (2°C), Marondera (2 °C) and Mhondoro (2°C) and surrounding areas**; The Zambezi Valley were cool at first and became warm by afternoon with scattered clouds. All other areas were mostly sunny and mild by afternoon and became cool towards evening.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: FRIDAY 29 MAY 2026



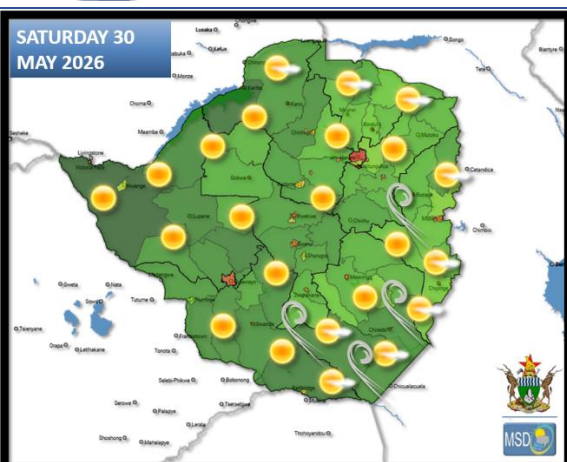
Countrywide:

Cold in the morning with slight ground frost in **Matopos, Gweru, Lupane, Mhondoro, Chibero, Henderson, Marondera, Hwedza, Rusape, and Nyanga**. Mostly sunny and mild by noon, becoming cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm especially in the morning and overnight.
- If a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.
- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from Agritex Officer (Agriculture Business Advisory Officer - ABAO)

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: SATURDAY 30 MAY 2026



Countrywide:

Cold at first, with mostly clear skies and slight ground frost in **Matopos, Gweru, Marondera and Nyanga**. Mild by afternoon, becoming windy towards evening with scattered clouds drifting into **Chiredzi, Beitbridge, Mwenezi and Chipinge Districts**.

Actions to Take:






- Keep warm; if a brazier or fire is used indoors to keep warm, ensure the room is well ventilated.
- Do not leave any fire unattended, whether indoor or outdoor. Ensure adult supervision in all cases.
- Monitor the temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local ABAO.
