



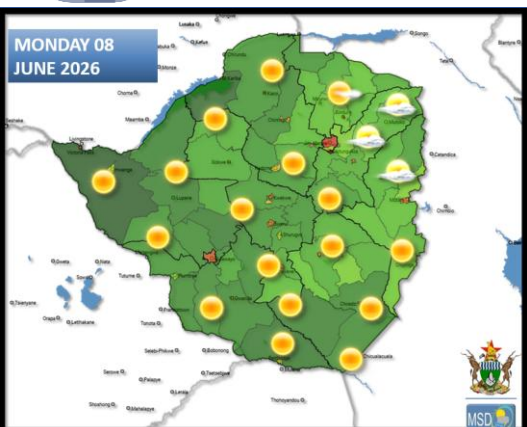
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 07 JUNE 2026



A mid-level cloud band over the northeastern parts of the country produced scattered thundershowers yesterday, with hail reported in some areas. The highest rainfall totals recorded were **8 mm** at **Agritex Chimukoko**, **6 mm** at **Harare Airport**, and **5 mm** at **Macheke Rail**. Slight ground frost was observed in **Gwanda (1°C)**, **Matopos (0°C)**, and **Plumtree (1°C)**.

Today, partly cloudy conditions prevailed over the northeastern areas, with isolated showers occurring in some places, while the rest of the country experienced mostly clear skies. Temperatures remained cold during the morning and evening periods, becoming mild during the day.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: MONDAY 08 JUNE 2026



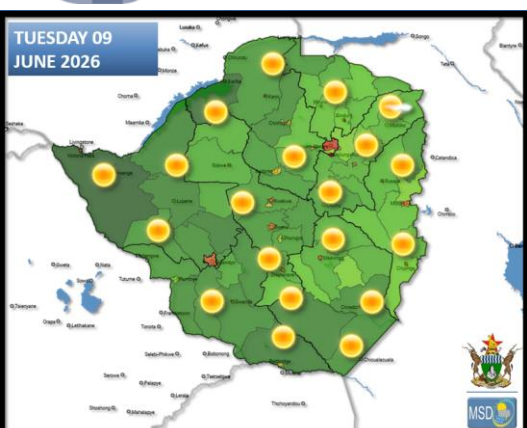
Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan, and Mashonaland East provinces: Cold in the morning, becoming warm and partly cloudy in the afternoon.

Masvingo, Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, Midlands Mashonaland West and Central provinces: Clear and cold at first with a chance of ground frost in areas such as Matopos and Gwanda. Mostly sunny and mild in the afternoon with light winds.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm especially in the morning and overnight.
- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from Agritex Officer
- Monitor temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local ABAO.

Countrywide: Mostly sunny and warm by day with cold morning and evening conditions. Slight ground frost is likely in frost prone areas such as Gwanda, Matopos, Gweru and Mazowe.
