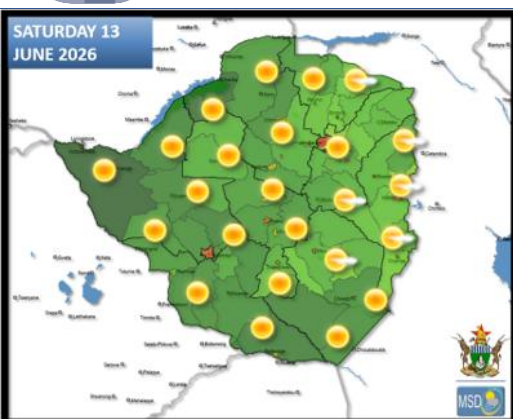
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 12 JUNE 2026



Overnight decrease in moisture led to very cold morning conditions in areas along the Highveld with moderate ground frost in **Nyanga (-1°C)** and **Gweru (0°C)**, while **slight ground frost was recorded in Matopos (2°C) and Chivhu (2°C)**. It was cold in all other areas, and became mild across the entire country by afternoon with mostly sunny conditions and light winds. Towards evening, temperatures decreased into the cold category again.

Meanwhile, relatively cool winds from the south-east coast of Southern Africa are slowly strengthening.

ALL AREAS:

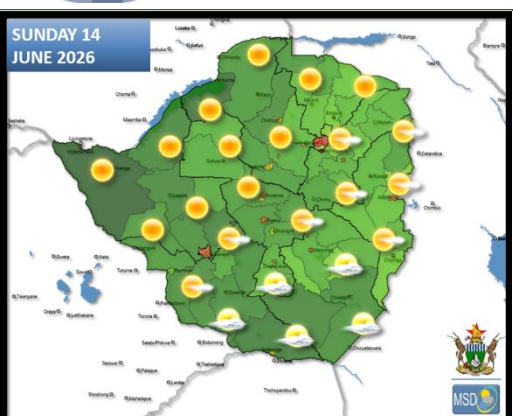
Cold and clear in the morning with slight ground frost in **Matopos, Nyanga, Marondera and Chivhu**. Warm by afternoon becoming windy and cold towards evening, more felt in **Chiredzi and Beitbridge districts**.

Actions to Take:



- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm especially in the morning and overnight.
- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from Agricultural Business Advisory Officer
- Monitor temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands provinces, Masvingo and southern parts of Manicaland provinces:

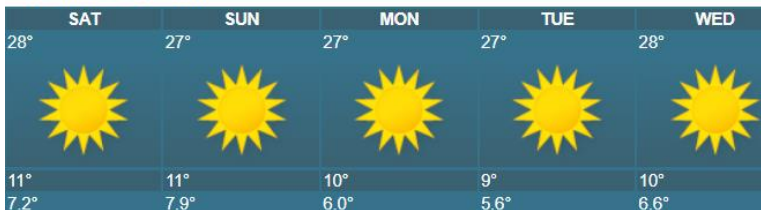

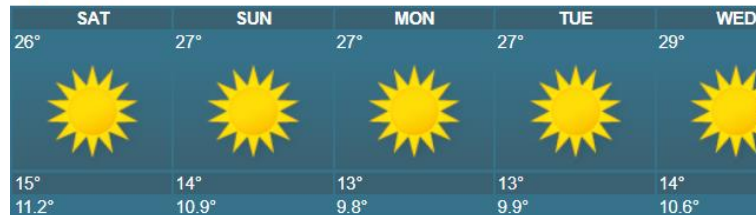
