SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 14 JUNE 2026



Cloudy, windy and cool conditions prevailed this morning over areas to the south of the Highveld, that is **Matabeleland South, Masvingo and the southern parts of Manicaland Province**. The associated moist airflow suppressed frost formation across the country. In areas along and north of the Highveld, skies were mostly clear and initially cold before becoming mild by afternoon. By afternoon, cloud cover over the southern areas gradually dissipated as the winds veered to an easterly direction.



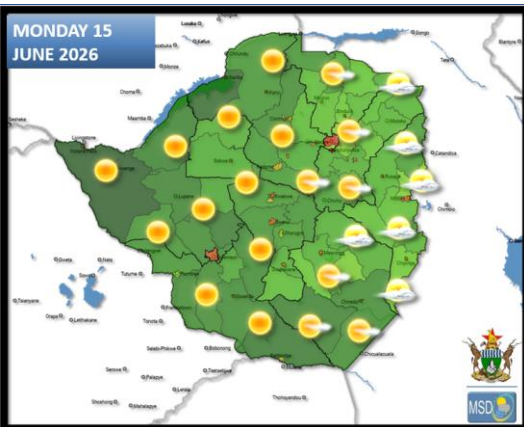

Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland West and Central provinces

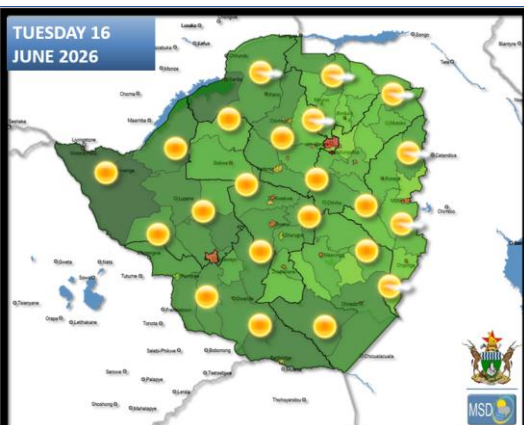

Actions to Take:

- **Frost mitigation measure, such as irrigating after midnight, should be put in place** advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer.

Cold at first with ground frost in **Matopos, Lupane, Gweru, Henderson, Marondera and Nyanga**. Mostly sunny and mild in the afternoon becoming cold overnight.

- **Monitor temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer.**
