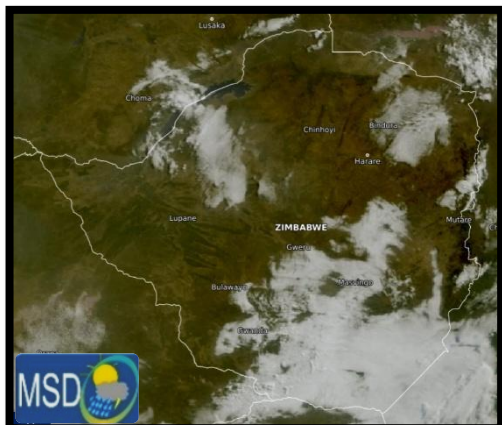




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 27 JUNE 2026



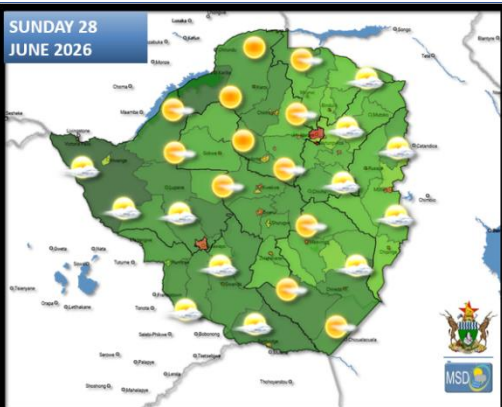
A cool, south-easterly airflow brought cloudy morning conditions to **Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Masvingo, the southern parts of the Midlands and Mashonaland West Provinces**, with fog observed in **Chivhu and Gwanda**. Elsewhere, clear and cold conditions prevailed. Moderate ground frost was recorded in **Matopos (-1°C)**, while **Rusape (1°C)** and **Nkayi (2°C)** had slight ground frost.

By afternoon, mild and partly cloudy conditions were experienced across much of the country.

Mashonaland East, Manicaland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands, and all Matabeleland Provinces:

Actions to Take:



Clear and cold in the morning with slight ground frost in areas such as Matopos, Gweru and Rusape, becoming partly cloudy and mild as the day progresses. Cold conditions should prevail overnight.

- **Keep warm. If there is need to use a brazier or fire indoors, ensure that the room is well ventilated.**
- **Use safe heating methods and avoid leaving open flames unattended indoors or outdoors.**
- **Frost mitigation measure may be required in some areas; seek advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (Agritex Officer).**

Mashonaland West and Central, Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, and Masvingo Provinces:

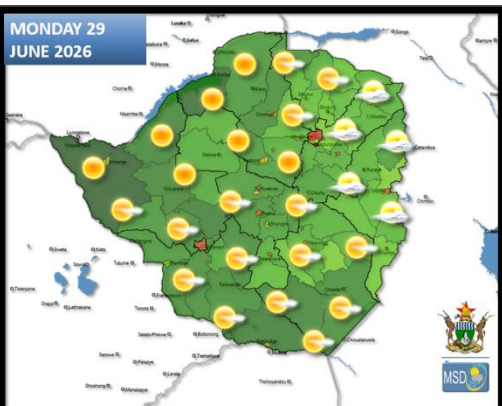
Actions to Take



Mostly sunny and mild for much of the day though cold in the morning and towards evening.

- **Keep warm especially overnight.**
- **Seek advice on redemptive and preventative measures against respiratory illnesses, such as cold and flu, from a certified medical practitioner.**

Mashonaland East, and Manicaland Provinces:

Actions to Take:



Cold morning conditions under clear skies. Slight ground frost is likely in Nyanga and Chivhu. Partly cloudy and mild conditions should prevail in the afternoon.

- **Dress in layers so you can adjust to the mild daytime conditions and colder mornings/evenings.**
- **Consume warm fluids such as tea or soup to help maintain body warmth and soothe the throat from adverse effects of the cold.**

Bulawayo Metropolitan, Mashonaland West and Central, Harare Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo, and all Matabeleland Provinces:

Actions to Take



Mostly clear skies and cold morning conditions, with slight ground frost in areas such as Matopos, Gwanda, and Gweru. Mild by day becoming cold towards evening.

- **Limit prolonged outdoor exposure during the cold morning and evening hours, especially for children and the elderly.**
- **Practice good hygiene — regular handwashing and covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing.**
