



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 01 JULY 2026



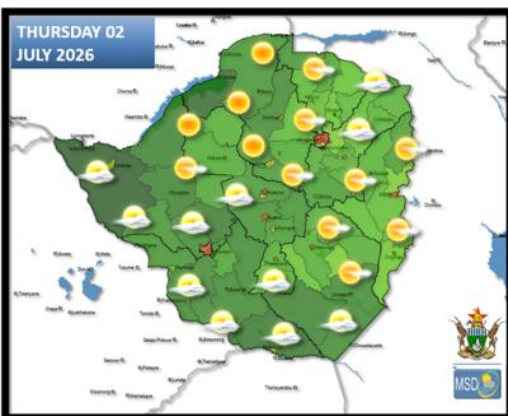
It was briefly cloudy and cool in **Beitbridge, Mwenezi, Chiredzi and Chipinge Districts** this morning, as cool moist south-easterly winds drove into **Matabeleland South, Masvingo and Manicaland Provinces**. By mid-morning these winds had start to veer into a warmer northerly direction.

Clear skies and cold morning conditions were in all other parts of the country, with slight ground frost in **Henderson (1°C), Nyanga (1°C), Gweru (2°C), Chivhu (2°C), and Matopos (2°C)**. It was mild by afternoon and became cold again by evening.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: THURSDAY 02 JULY 2026



Eastern parts of Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Cold in the early morning hours with mostly clear skies and slight ground frost in areas such as **Henderson, Gweru, Chivhu, Marondera and Nyanga**. Warm in the afternoon, becoming cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Dress in layers, to be able to adjust to the warmer afternoon conditions. Keep Hydrated and wear a sunhat.
- Use safe methods to keep warm; in case of use of fire, avoid leaving it unattended, indoors or outdoors.
- Frost mitigation measure may be required in some areas; seek advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (Agritex Officer).

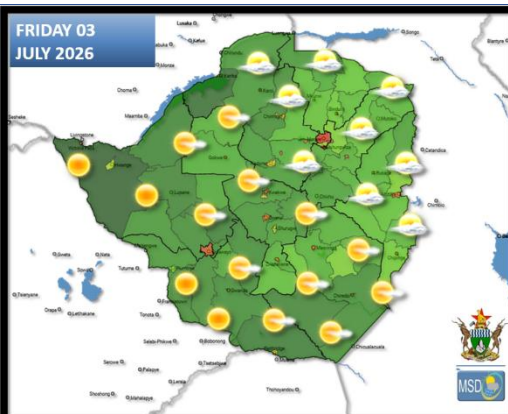
Bulawayo Metropolitan, western parts of Midlands, Masvingo, and all Matabeleland Provinces:

Cold at first, becoming mild by noon with scattered clouds overhead. Cold again overnight.

Actions to Take

- Keep warm especially overnight.
- Seek advice on redemptive and preventative measures against respiratory illnesses, such as cold and flu, from a certified medical practitioner.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: FRIDAY 03 JULY 2026



Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, and Masvingo Provinces:

Mostly clear skies and cold in the morning, with slight ground frost in areas such as **Matopos, Gweru and Lupane**. Mild in the afternoon, becoming cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Keep warm. If there is need to use a brazier or fire indoors, ensure that the room is well ventilated.
- Consume warm fluids such as tea or soup to help maintain body warmth and soothe the throat from adverse effects of temperature fluctuations.
- Frost mitigation measure may be required in some areas; seek advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (Agritex Officer).

Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Warm in the afternoon with scattered cloud, though cool in the morning and cold towards evening.

Actions to Take

- Dress in layers, to be able to adjust to the warmer afternoon conditions. Keep Hydrated and wear a sunhat.
