



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 28 JUNE 2026



Cold morning conditions prevailed across much of the country, with moderate ground frost recorded in **Gweru (0°C)** and cloudy conditions affecting parts of the eastern and southern districts.

By afternoon, mild and mostly sunny conditions were experienced across much of the country, except for Manicaland and parts of Mashonaland East, which remained partly cloudy.

Manicaland and parts of Mashonaland East:

Actions to Take:



Clear and cold at first with slight ground frost in areas such as Rusape and Nyanga, becoming partly cloudy and mild as the day progresses. Cold conditions should prevail overnight.

- **Keep warm. If there is need to use a brazier or fire indoors, ensure that the room is well ventilated.**
- **Use safe heating methods and avoid leaving open flames unattended indoors or outdoors.**
- **Frost mitigation measure may be required in some areas; seek advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (Agritex Officer).**

Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, all Matabeleland, Masvingo, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland West and Central, Provinces:

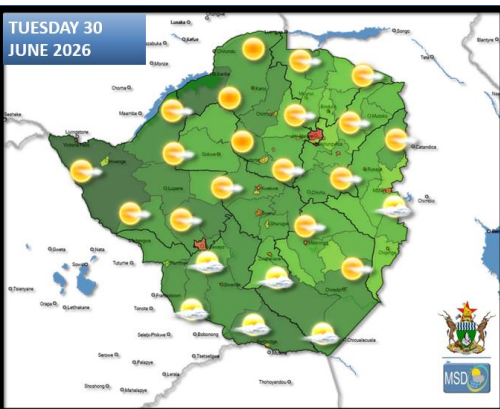
Actions to Take



Mostly sunny and mild for much of the day though cold in the morning and towards evening. Slight ground frost is probable in areas such as Matopos, Gwanda, and Gweru and Chivhu.

- **Keep warm especially overnight.**
- **Seek advice on redemptive and preventative measures against respiratory illnesses, such as cold and flu, from a certified medical practitioner.**

Matabeleland South and southern parts of Midlands:

Actions to Take:



Cold and clear in the morning with a chance of slight ground frost in Matopos, Gwanda, and Gweru and Chivhu. Partly cloudy and mild in the afternoon and cold towards evening.

- **Dress in layers so you can adjust to the mild daytime conditions and colder mornings/evenings.**
- **Consume warm fluids such as tea or soup to help maintain body warmth and soothe the throat from adverse effects of the cold.**

Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, Manicaland and all Mashonaland Provinces

Actions to Take



Mostly clear skies and cold morning conditions, with a chance of slight ground frost in areas such as Nyanga. Mild as the day progresses, becoming cold towards evening.

- **Limit prolonged outdoor exposure during the cold morning and evening hours, especially for children and the elderly.**
