



10 DAY AGROMET BULLETIN

SUMMARY OF THE PAST DEKAD 01-06-2026 TO 10-06-2026

Generally sunny conditions dominated during the period, with cold mornings and reports of slight ground frost in the traditional frost-prone areas. These included Matopos, Kezi, Gwanda and Plumtree in Matabeleland South; Nkayi in Matabeleland North; Nyanga in Manicaland; Gweru in the Midlands; Chivhu in Mashonaland East; and Henderson in Mashonaland Central. Partly cloudy and warm conditions were also experienced over the northern parts of the country due to a cloud band moving in from the west. This resulted in isolated thundershowers over the weekend.

On Sunday, 7 June 2026, isolated thunderstorms were recorded in areas such as Agritex Chimukoko, which received 8 mm, Robert Gabriel Mugabe International Airport, which received 6 mm, and Macheke Rail, which received 5 mm. A hailstorm was also observed in Harare Province.

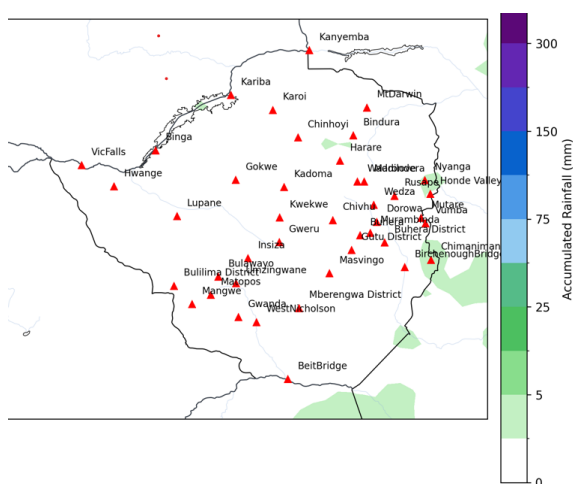


Fig 1: 10 day outlook

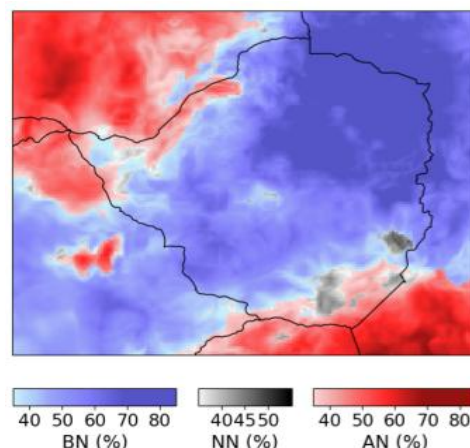


Fig 2: June 2026 temperature outlook

Mostly sunny and warm afternoon conditions are expected across much of the country. Mornings and evenings should remain cold over the central parts of the country, while cool to mild conditions are expected over the Zambezi Valley and Save Valley.

However, a brief cloudy interlude is anticipated over the southern and eastern parts of the country, particularly Matabeleland South, Masvingo and Manicaland provinces, between 15 and 18 June. This cloud cover is expected to reduce the risk of frost occurrence during this period.

- Frost can damage sensitive crops, resulting in reduced growth, wilting, and possible crop loss. Horticultural crops, tobacco seedlings, beans, tomatoes, potatoes, and young winter wheat are especially susceptible. Consult your local Agritex Extension officers for area-specific frost mitigation measures.
- During cold nights and mornings. Livestock farmers should provide appropriate shelter, bedding and warmth to safeguard their livestock against hypothermia.
