

**10 DAY AGROMET BULLETIN****SUMMARY OF THE PAST DEKAD 11-06-2026 TO 20-06-2026**

Generally sunny conditions dominated during the period, with cold mornings and reports of slight ground frost in the traditional frost-prone areas. These included Matopos, Kezi, Gwanda and Plumtree in Matabeleland South; Nkayi in Matabeleland North; Nyanga in Manicaland; Gweru in the Midlands; Chivhu in Mashonaland East; and Henderson in Mashonaland Central.

Dekad concluded with drizzle and rain over the southern and eastern districts of the country, where Nyanga (Manicaland) recorded 11mm, Chisumbanje (Manicaland) 4mm and Zaka (Masvingo) 4mm.

WEATHER OUTLOOK: JUNE 2026

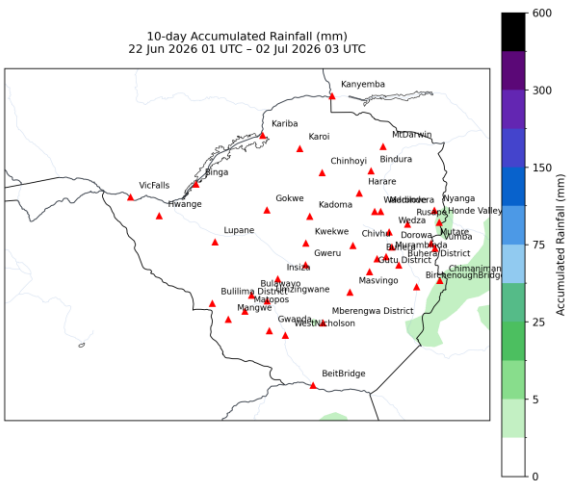


Fig 1 :10-day precipitation outlook

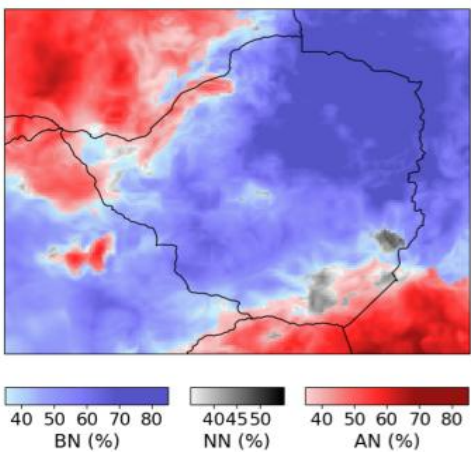


Fig 2: June 2026 temperature outlook

Mostly sunny conditions with mild afternoons are expected across the country. Cold mornings and evenings will prevail over most areas, while the Zambezi Valley and Save Valley will experience relatively mild conditions.

Risk of ground frost occurrence will be heightened, particularly in frost prone areas such as Matopos in Matabeleland South, Gweru in Midlands, Nyanga in Manicaland, Henderson in Mashonaland Central and Chivhu in Mashonaland Central.

A brief cloudy spell is expected over Matabeleland South and Manicaland provinces from the 26th to the 27th of June, reducing the likelihood of frost in these areas.

Temperatures in June 2026 are still expected to be generally cooler than average across much of the country, except for areas in the lowveld which are expected to be relatively warmer than average (Fig 2).
