



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 25 JULY 2026



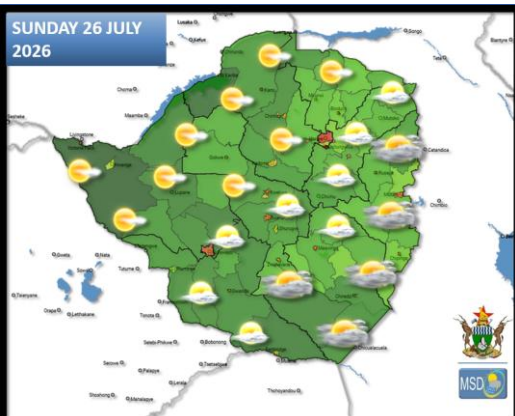
The southern and eastern parts of the country began the day under cloudy, windy, and cold conditions, accompanied by drizzle in **Nyanga and Mukandi**. Elsewhere, skies were mostly clear with light winds.

By afternoon, southern areas remained mild under cloudy skies, while much of the country experienced warm conditions. Temperatures dropped later in the evening, bringing back cold overnight conditions.

Matabeleland South, Masvingo and the southern parts of Midlands, and Manicaland Provinces.

Briefly cloudy, windy and cold in the morning with a chance of drizzle in some areas. Becoming mild as the day progresses. Cold towards evening.

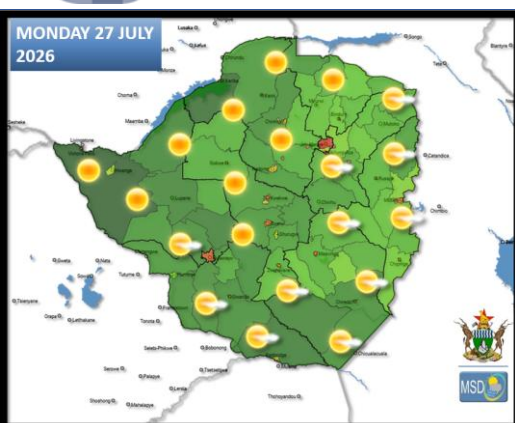
Matabeleland North, Bulawayo metropolitan, northern parts of Midlands, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces.

Mostly sunny and mild with light winds for much of the day. Morning and evening should remain cold.

Actions to Take:

- Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm especially in the morning and overnight.
- Monitor temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (ABAO).

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: MONDAY 27 JULY 2026



All areas:

Cold and clear in the morning with slight ground frost in areas such as Buhera, Chivhu Gwanda, Gweru, Kezi, Nkayi, Nyanga and Rusape.

Warm in the afternoon under mostly sunny skies.

Actions to Take:

- Monitor temperature within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (ABAO).
- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from Agritex Officer
