



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 06 AUGUST 2026



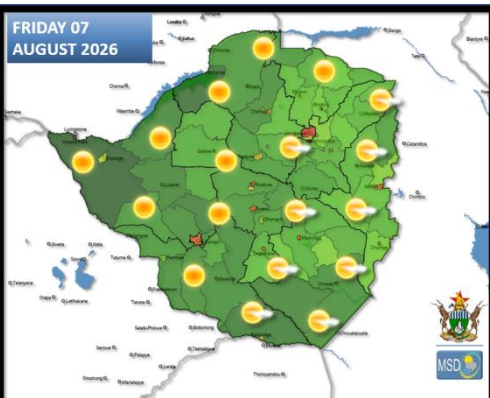
This morning, very cold conditions were experienced across much of the country, with severe ground frost in **Nyanga (-2°C)** as a result of dry air and clear skies experienced overnight. Moderate ground frost was reported in **Matopos (-1°C)** and **Chivhu (-1°C)**, while slight ground frost was observed in **Gweru (0°C)**, **Masvingo (0°C)**, and **West Nicholson (1°C)**. As the day progressed, mostly sunny and warm conditions were experienced countrywide.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: FRIDAY 07 AUGUST 2026



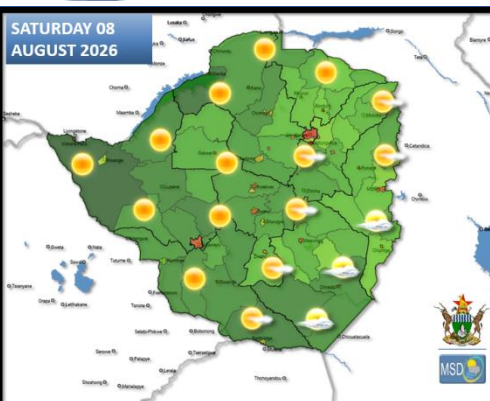
ALL AREAS:

Clear and cold at first with slight to moderate ground frost in **Chivhu, Plumtree, Nkayi, Matopos, Gweru, Nyanga and Rusape**. Mild in the afternoon, becoming cold towards evening.

Actions to Take:

- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (ABAO).
- Monitor temperatures within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from Agritex Officers.

All Matabeleland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, northern parts of Masvingo, Northern parts of Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland Provinces.

Sunny and warm by day with cold conditions both in the morning and towards evening. Ground frost in the morning is expected in districts such as **Chivhu, Nkayi, Matopos, Gweru, Lupane, Henderson, Nyanga, and Rusape**.

Briefly cloudy and cool in the morning, becoming mostly sunny and mild as the day progresses. Cold conditions towards evening.
