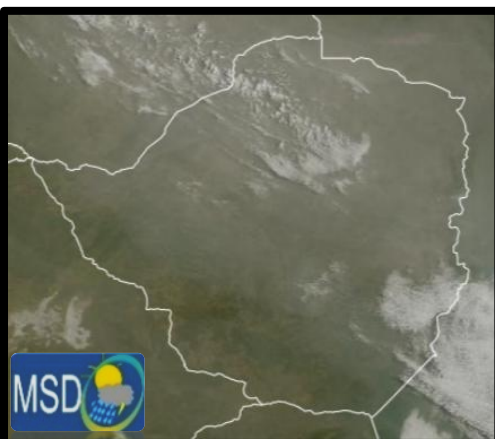




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 10 AUGUST 2026



Today, Matopos had moderate ground frost (-2°C), while the rest of the country woke to chilly morning conditions.

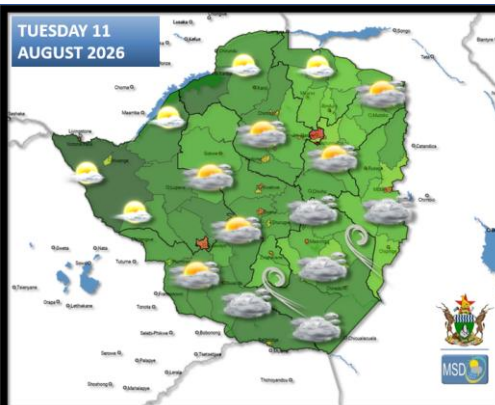


As the day progressed, most areas experienced brief cloudy periods, light winds, and mild conditions, though a few locations in the far north remained mostly sunny throughout. Meanwhile, southeasterly winds are gradually picking up strength over the southern parts of the country.

Mostly cloudy, cool and windy for much of the day with a chance of light rain and drizzle in some areas. Cold in the morning and at night.

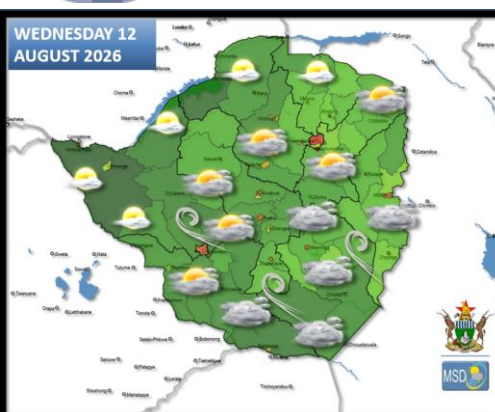
Northern parts of Matabeleland North, northern parts Midlands, Mashonaland West and Central provinces:

Cold under clear skies at first, becoming mild and partly cloudy as the day progresses. Light winds should be felt time and again.

Actions to Take:

- Implement frost prevention measures where necessary, with advice from your local Agricultural Business Advisory Officer (ABAO).
- Monitor temperatures within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from Agritex Officers.

Matabeleland South, southern parts of Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Midlands, Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan and Mashonaland East provinces:

Cloudy, cold and windy in the morning with a chance of light rain and drizzle in some areas. Cool conditions are expected in the afternoon.

Northern parts of Matabeleland North, northern parts Midlands, Mashonaland West and Central provinces:

Partly cloudy, cool and windy for much of the day. Mornings and evenings should remain cold.
