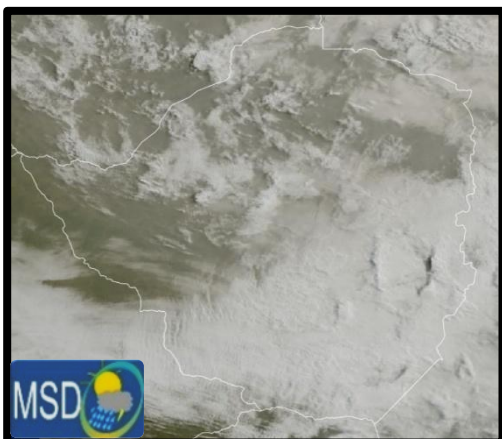




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 12 AUGUST 2026



Cool and relatively moist south-easterly winds, coupled with a mid-level low-pressure system, resulted in light to moderate rainfall across the southern and eastern parts of the country yesterday. The highest amounts recorded were **33mm in Mutasa Zindi, 11mm in Chisumbanje and 7mm in Buffalo Range.**

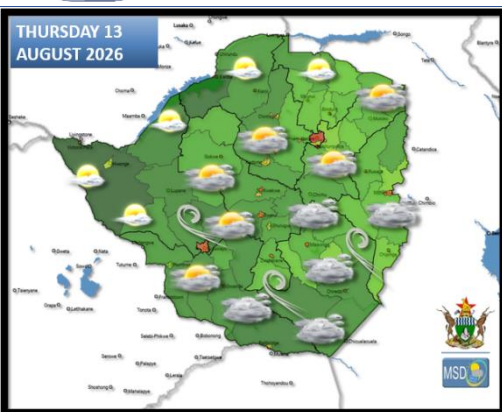
By this morning, the mid-level system had weakened, leading to cold, cloudy and windy conditions across much of the country, with drizzle in some places. During the afternoon, the north-western districts became mild under partly cloudy skies, while the rest of the country remained cloudy and cool for most of the day.

Cloudy, windy and cool for much of the day, with a chance of light rain and drizzle in some areas. Cold conditions are expected in towards evening.

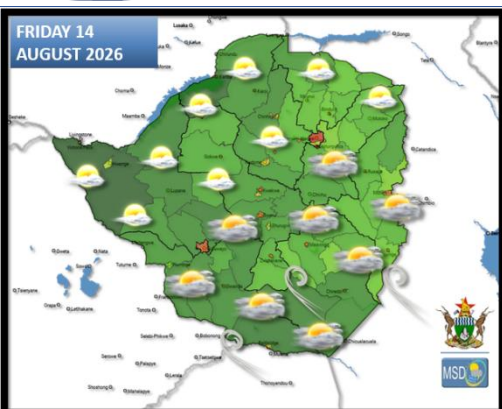
Mashonaland West, and the northern parts of Matabeleland North:

Partly cloudy, windy and cool at first becoming mild by the afternoon. It should be cold overnight.

- Monitor temperatures within fowl runs and adjust accordingly, with advice from Agritex Officers.

Matabeleland South, southern parts of Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Midlands, Manicaland, Harare Metropolitan and Mashonaland East provinces:

Mostly cloudy, cold and windy morning conditions, with a chance drizzle in some areas. Cool conditions are expected in the afternoon becoming cold towards evening.

Northern parts of Matabeleland North, northern parts Midlands, Mashonaland West and Central provinces:

Partly cloudy and cool for much of the day with light winds. Cold conditions both in the morning and towards evening.
