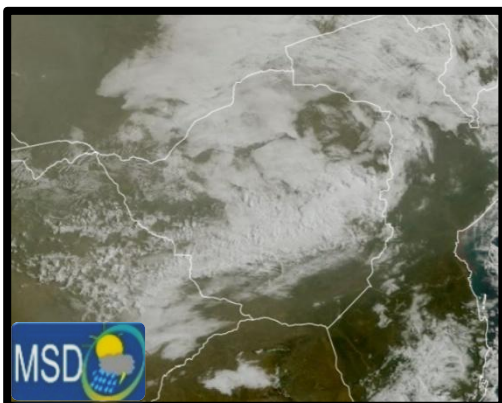




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 14 AUGUST 2026



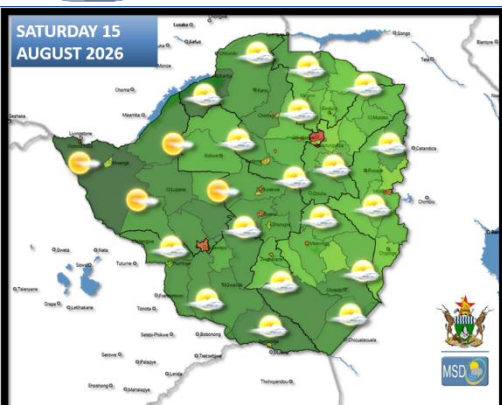
Most parts of the country experienced cloudy, windy and cold conditions this morning, with some parts of Matabeleland South, Masvingo and Manicaland Provinces experiencing drizzle and rain. Highest rainfall amounts recorded in 14mm in Chisengu and 12mm in Chipinge. However, by afternoon, it became cool with partly cloudy conditions. Towards evening, temperatures dropped again resulting in cold conditions.

Partly cloudy and cool for much of the day with light winds. Cold conditions both in the morning and overnight.

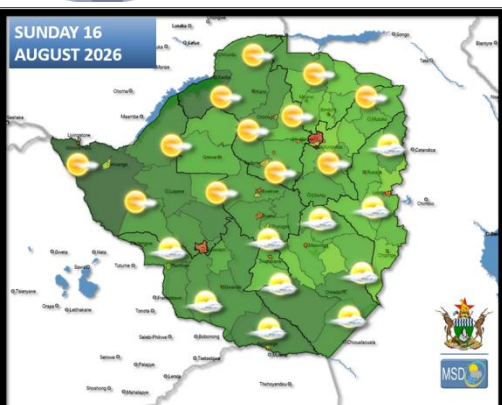
Matabeleland North, and northern parts Midlands provinces:

Mostly sunny and warm for much of the day with light winds. Cold conditions both in the morning and overnight.

Actions to Take:

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, southern parts of Midlands, and Manicaland

Cool with partly cloudy conditions by day, though cold both in the morning and towards evening.

Matabeleland North, northern parts Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, and All Mashonaland provinces:

Cold morning conditions, becoming mild by the afternoon under mostly clear skies. Cold conditions are expected towards evening.
