

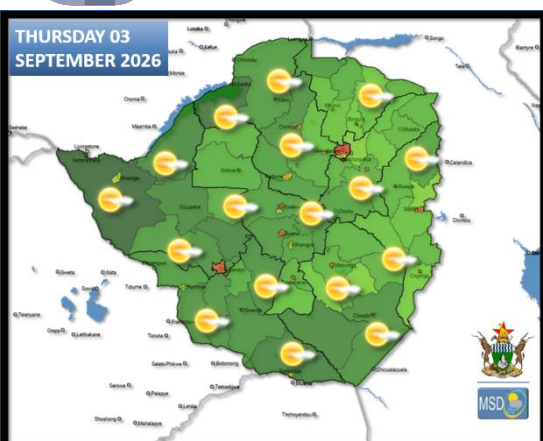
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 02 SEPTEMBER 2026

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: THURSDAY 03 SEPTEMBER 2026



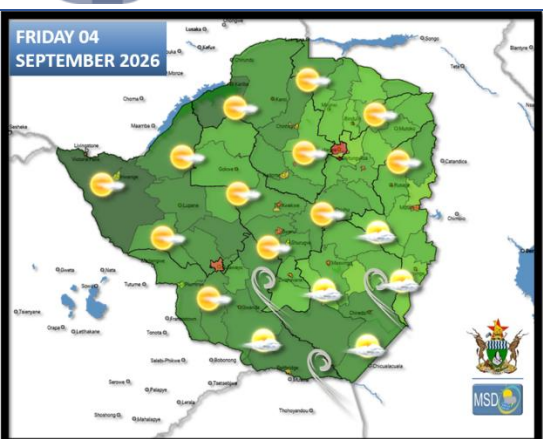
All Areas:

Harare and Bulawayo Metropolitans, Matabeleland North, Midlands and all Mashonaland Provinces:

Mostly sunny and warm conditions in the morning. Warm conditions and with light winds are expected as the day progresses. Cool overnight conditions are expected.

Matabeleland South, Masvingo and Manicaland Provinces:

Mostly sunny and cool in the morning, becoming partly cloudy and windy by the afternoon. Cool and windy conditions expected in the evening.

- **Ensure the young and elderly are kept warm especially in the morning and overnight.**
