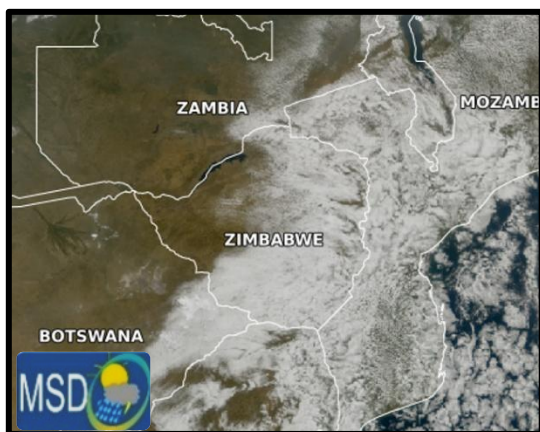




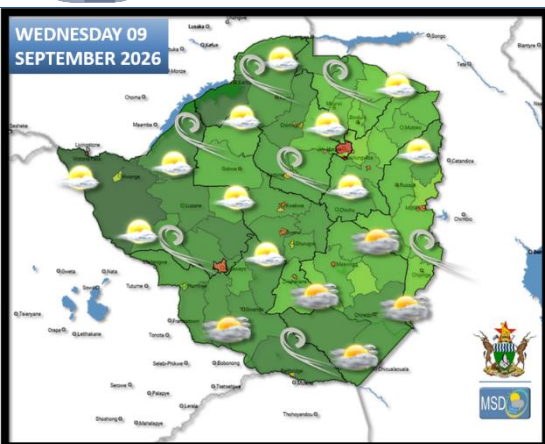
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, TUESDAY 08 SEPTEMBER 2026



Yesterday, isolated thundershowers occurred over much of Matabeleland South, Masvingo and southern parts of Midlands provinces. The highest rainfall totals were recorded in **Kezi (6mm), West Beitbridge(6mm), and West Nicholson(5mm)**. Light rain and drizzle were experienced in Gweru, Zvishavane, Marondera, Buhera, Chipinge, Nyanga, and Mhondoro districts.

Today, the abundant moisture over much of the country led to mostly cloudy and cool conditions in the morning except for areas in parts of Mashonaland West and Matabeleland North which were under clear skies. As the day progressed these conditions persisted with warm conditions being experienced in the afternoon over the northern and western parts of the country.

Matabeleland South, Masvingo, Mashonaland East, and Manicaland provinces:

Briefly cloudy, windy and cool at first, becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with a chance of odd showers. Cool conditions overnight.

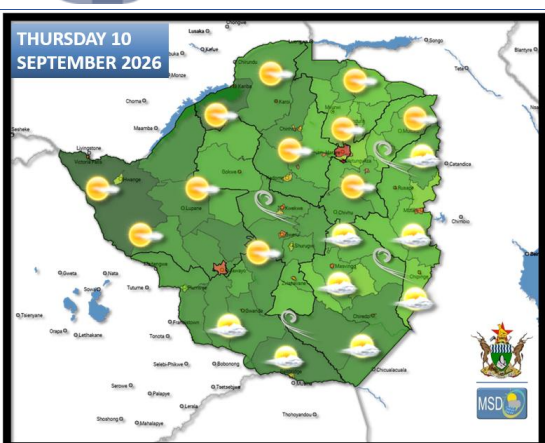
Matabeleland North, Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland West and Mashonaland Central provinces:

Partly cloudy and cool in the morning, becoming warm in the afternoon with light winds. Cool conditions overnight.
